Mathematics**

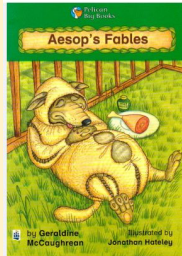
Maths-

This term we will be revisiting place value and learning how to write and read numbers up to 1000.

English

We are closely reading Aesop's fables.

We are revisiting writing accurate sentences and using conjunctions. We will be identifying and using direct speech. We will learn how to use inverted commas and Synonyms of the word *said*.



History

Prehistoric Britain

In history, we will be concentrating on life in prehistoric Britain. This will focus on the changes from the Stone Age, into the Bronze Age and finally the Iron Age.



Geography

Spatial Sense

In Geography this term, we will be learning the skills required to read maps successfully. We will be looking at the symbols used and reading grid references.
