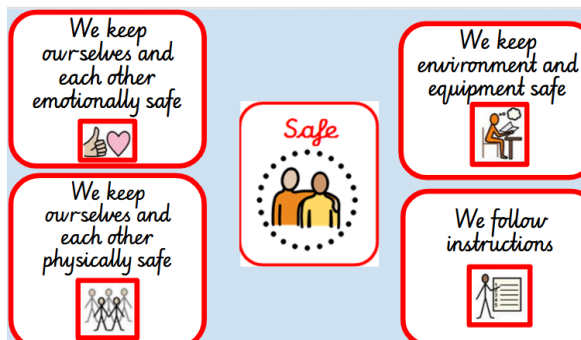
FAMILY WORKER - Mrs Rawling
