Children have loved chilling out and exploring the new artificial grass, cross, mound and umbrella shelters.


We hope the investment in the space will be respected and ready for 1000s of children to come.





Children will be gently reminded on the first occasion; a dojo will be sent on the second and a letter on the third with consequences


Forest School- A quarter of the year group will go on their PE day. They require

- Wellies






