CAR PARK SAFETY



We are becoming increasingly concerned with people's behaviour around the car park and cars at the end of the school day.

We have witnessed near misses where adults with buggies, young children on scooters and children being allowed to run past moving cars, have nearly been knocked over.

We ask all of our community adults to be role models in moving around safely and avoiding the cars.

We now propose a change to how we use the carpark:

- Do not move cars between 3.10 and 3.20pm.
- Only apply for car park passes where absolutely necessary.
 - Walkers only use paths
- Do not walk through the car park
