Year 5 has been learning to screen paint. This is an art skill that takes precision and perseverance, so we are thrilled with the results. Well done Napoleon class.

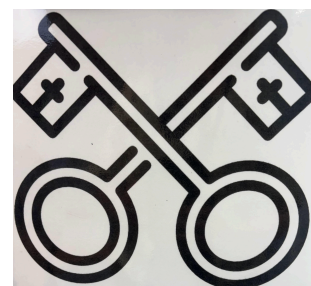


3rd Pillar of PASSION in practice
