FIDGET AND SQUISHIE BAN

We hate doing this, but lots of children are bringing in multiple toys, fidgets and squishies to school for playtime.

There has even been trading happening between children.

As you can imagine, this has occupied a lot of adult time when it has gone wrong and so

we have been forced to ban squishies or fidgets or toys from home.

- Children have become upset because they don't have them
 - Items have been lost
 - Items have been broken
- Children have fallen out with each other.
- Children have had red cards for going each other bags to trade... THE LIST GOES ON!

If your child needs a comfort toy or a fidget, this needs to be agreed by the class teacher and SENCo to ensure that it matches their needs whilst in school. Remember most research says that fidget toys are more of a distraction than a support. **Also, if the items are purchased from places outside of the UK they are not always up to UK trading standards and can cause harm!**

When we make the wrong choices, it is normally to communicate that something is wrong and maybe we can't find the words to say what it is, or even determine what is exactly the problem.

However, if the behaviour is disruptive, it starts to impact others.

People can start to feel scared or upset themselves because their safety is being affected.

People can start to get annoyed because their learning time is being stopped.

Behaviour that impacts on others always has consequences; not always just the yellow or red consequences, but ones that last in the thoughts of others.
