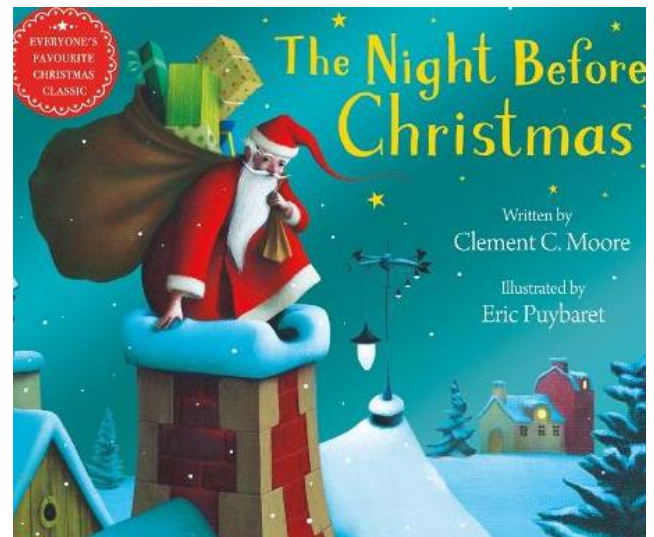
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### A St Peter's Night Before Christmas

We ask that our children are all in school uniform.

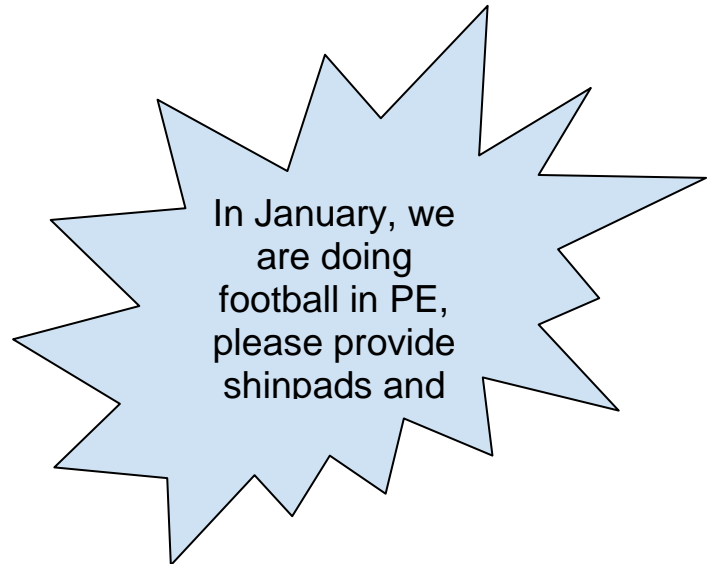
- Grey or black bottoms.

- **NO SPORTING TEAM KITS**



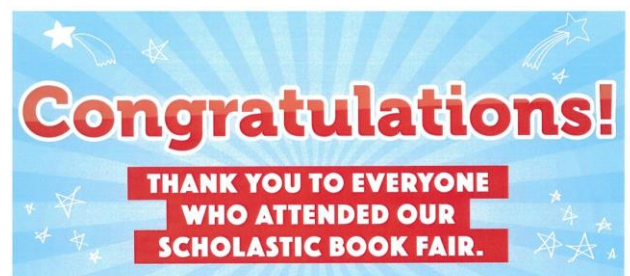
