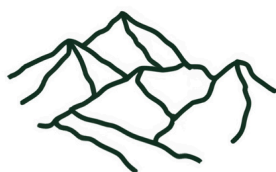

Our Minions Summer Camp brought together 70 girls and 20 leaders from across Sydney for a week of friendship, formation and fun.



The days were full: team challenges, a scavenger hunt, night games, but it was the spirit of the camp that stood out most. Alongside all the laughter and activity, the girls took part in sessions on service and active listening, learning in simple but meaningful ways how to be more attentive, generous and aware of others.



This summer also marked the beginning of something new. "Learning to Lead", our new program for Year 8 girls, was launched with a focus on principle-centred living, teamwork and leading by example. It has already begun to lay strong foundations for the girls as they grow in confidence and responsibility.



At the same time, 40 university students from Sydney and Brisbane gathered at Creston College for the three-day Summit Conference. It was a time of both depth and joy, where talks, workshops, social activities and prayer came together to strengthen their faith and renew their sense of mission.



A New Chapter for Eremeran

Behind the scenes, this year has also marked a significant transition. In late 2025, we said a temporary goodbye to our Stevens Street home as preparations began for the new Eremeran centre, which will be built on the same site. Demolition began in March, and we are now looking ahead to an expected opening in October 2027.



While leaving a place so full of memories was not easy, the move has opened up new opportunities. Eremeran has found a temporary home in Thornleigh, and already it has become a place of life and activity. Thanks to the generosity of our community, more than 150 young (and not so young!) women have passed through its doors this term.



Each week has had its own rhythm. Monday afternoons have seen high school girls gathering for study groups, working side by side in a focused but supportive environment. University students have continued to meet for formation evenings through the Prayer IRL workshop series, while mothers' gatherings have offered space for connection and encouragement.



Young professionals have come together for talks and socials, building friendships alongside shared purpose. Fridays have been filled with the creativity and energy of Club 56, from making macramé plant holders to preparing Lenten food packs, while Saturdays have brought a mix of high school activities, from Olympics-style games to games nights and Paint & Sip evenings. The term also included a Year 11 retreat, offering time for reflection and renewal amid a busy season of life.

There is a strong sense that something is continuing to grow, quietly, steadily, and with purpose. We look forward to returning home one day, renewed and ready for the next chapter.
