This contract is required for all dogs and puppies adopted from Sullivan Sanctuary of Maine who are not yet spayed or neutered at the time of adoption.

The adopter understands and agrees that:

- The surgery must be performed by a licensed veterinarian.
- Proof of surgery (vet receipt or medical record) must be submitted to Sullivan Sanctuary of Maine within 7 days of the procedure.
- Failure to comply may result in:
 - The animal being reclaimed by Sullivan Sanctuary of Maine
 - Denial of future adoptions
 - Possible legal action as allowed under Maine law

Some adoptions may require a refundable spay/neuter deposit.

Medical or Age-Related Delays

If a veterinarian determines the animal is temporarily unable to undergo surgery due to age, illness, or medical risk, the adopter must:

- Provide written documentation from the veterinarian
- Follow the revised timeline approved by Sullivan Sanctuary of Maine
- Understand that extensions are granted only with proper veterinary documentation

No Breeding Clause

The adopter agrees that:

- The animal will not be bred, intentionally or accidentally
- The animal will be kept securely to prevent accidental mating
- Any offspring resulting from failure to comply are the legal property of Sullivan Sanctuary of Maine
- Breeding (intentional or accidental) is grounds for immediate contract violation

Right to Verify

Sullivan Sanctuary of Maine reserves the right to:

- Contact the veterinarian to confirm the appointment or completion
- Request updated proof if documentation is unclear

Ownership Status

Ownership of the animal is not considered final until:

- The spay/neuter surgery is completed
- Proof is submitted and approved
