

YEAR 1- COURSES AND DESCRIPTIONS

1

Bible Study Methods & Rules of Interpretation

40 hours

A foundational, skills-based course teaching students how to observe, interpret, and apply Scripture for personal growth and ministry.

Requirement: None

2

Old Testament Survey

60 hours

A comprehensive reading of the Old Testament, helping students understand each book's structure, themes, and message, and how it points to the New Testament.

Requirement: Course #1

3

New Testament Survey

60 hours

A full study of the New Testament focused on each book's structure, themes, and message. Emphasis is placed on Jesus as the fulfillment of the Old Testament and on personal application of Scripture.

Requirement: Course #1 and #2

4

Bible Doctrine Survey

60 hours

An overview of key doctrines from Genesis to Revelation, addressing major life questions. Students build sound theology, discern false teaching, and align belief with practice.

Requirement: Course #1, #2, and #3

5

Personal and Corporate Spiritual Life

55 hours

A study of 37 topics covering personal spiritual growth and daily Christian living, along with foundational principles of church life and the believer's role in the Body of Christ.

Requirement: Course #1, #2, #3, and #4

Each course must be taken consecutively and will be offered on a continuing basis.
