The good news: Parents can set simple, empowering boundaries that teach kids *how* to use AI without fear. Think of it as driver's ed for the digital age.

5 Family Rules for Al

- 1. **Show Your Work** Share AI conversations openly.
- 2. **Human First** Big emotions and decisions go to real people *first*.
- 3. **Check Sources** Don't accept Al answers without verifying.
- 4. **Time Box It** Use AI in set windows, not as a late-night escape.
- 5. **Purpose Before Play** Decide why you're opening it before you start.

Closing Thought

Parenting in the AI age isn't about panic or pretending it doesn't exist. It's about raising kids who can think for themselves, value human connection, and use AI as a *tool*, not a crutch.

What makes your child irreplaceable isn't their ability to use technology. It's their ability to do what AI cannot be fully, beautifully human.
