Effective **June 29th, 2026**, all fire departments within Tangipahoa Parish require fire and life safety system inspection, testing, and maintenance reports to be uploaded to the [FireModule](#) web-portal. The Parish departments adopted FireModule to improve community safety through increased compliance of fire and life safety systems. FireModule is designed to efficiently track and resolve past due and deficient systems, which benefits both community safety and inspection companies operating in the area. All inspection companies performing work within Tangipahoa Parish boundaries are obligated to comply.

New Reporting Requirements

- Required inspection reports, identified in the table below, need to be uploaded to [FireModule](#) within **7 days** of the inspection date
- Inspection companies should submit deficiency repair reports as soon as possible. If customers refuse to update or fix deficiencies, please add a comment to your inspection submission so that we can prioritize those businesses for enforcement.
