Homeschool Instructions for 2026-27 School Year:

* Please read these instructions carefully, especially the new requirements for Grades 1 & 2 students.

Grades 1-6:

1. **Read the chapter/session** in the *Finding God* textbook. *QR code activities are optional.*
2. **Complete the Interactive Session Review.** If necessary retake it until a score of 100% is achieved.

 - Select your child's grade level and scroll down to locate the review for the appropriate chapter/session.
 - At the end of the review, enter a **parent email** address to receive the results.

3. **NEW! Attend the In-Person workshops** for homeschool families. *Dates/times to be shared in September.*
4. **Record your child's progress** using either the [Paper Homeschool Log](#) or the [Google Form Homeschool Log](#). When all chapters are complete, submit the paper log or email us to confirm completion.

Additional Requirements for **Grade 1 & 2 Students** only:

In addition to the steps above Grade 1 & 2 students should:

1. **Complete all questions and activities** in the textbook for each chapter/session.
2. **Return the textbook** to the Religious Education Office after completing all 25 chapters/sessions and their corresponding activities/questions.

Book Units:

The *Finding God* textbooks are divided into five units, with five chapters in each unit. Every unit begins with several pages about a saint. Please have your child read these pages and, for Grade 1 & 2 students, complete any accompanying activities or questions.

The final chapter in each unit focuses on a liturgical season or celebration: **Session 5:** Ordinary Time, **Session 10:** Advent, **Session 15:** Christmas, **Session 20:** Lent, **Session 25:** Easter.



I encourage you to do these chapters during the corresponding season and invite your child to notice how the themes connect to what they see at Mass, including the church decorations and liturgical colors.

If your child is completing the chapters in order, they may also play the [Fishers of Faith: Unit Review game](#) at the end of each unit. This activity is completely optional and is intended as a fun way to review what they have learned. There is no need to record completion or achieve a perfect score.
