

Saint Report for Confirmation 2:

At Confirmation it is traditional to take a new name to signify your new awareness of how Confirmation will help you live as a disciple of Christ. Candidates often choose the name of a saint for whom they have an affinity (a natural liking or similarity too). This saint will then act as the person's patron and guide on his or her faith journey through life.



In preparation for choosing your Confirmation name, all candidates are required to research the life of a Saint and choose one as their patron. Candidates are asked to complete a brief report about the Saint they have chosen. This should be turned in either by an emailed photo of both sides of this paper or physically to a meeting no later than October 25, 2026.

Candidates should answer the questions below in complete sentences where required.

The Religious Education office has many books of saints you may borrow, or you can research your saint on the internet using sites such as Catholic Online: <https://www.catholic.org/saints/stindex.php>. You can also google a name or a specific Catholic Saint to learn about that person. Be sure to read about the Saint and pick a Saint who represents you or possesses qualities you would like to emulate (to copy or imitate).
