Attendance and Punctuality

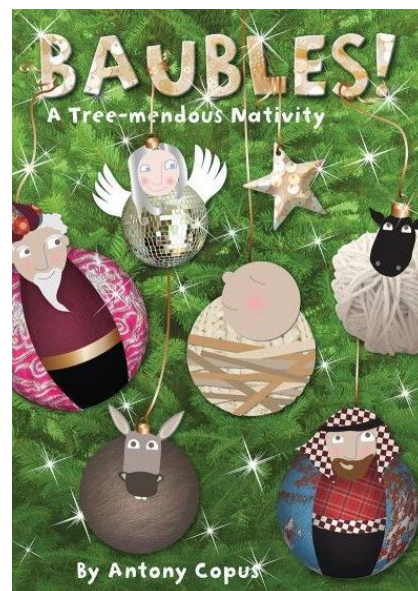
