4 Top Tips for Supporting a Child with SEND:

Establish clear routines: SEND children often thrive on predictability. Create a stable, structured environment at home to reduce anxiety.

Use visual tools: Visual timetables help children know what to expect, aiding transition and daily functioning.

Break tasks down: Simplify learning or daily tasks into small, manageable steps to make them feel less overwhelming.

Partner with school: Build a collaborative relationship with teachers. Discuss your child's needs, ask for regular updates, and ensuring everyone works together.
