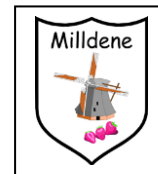


# Milldene Primary School Newsletter

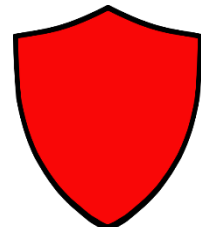
