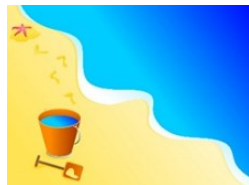
Wriggle and Crawl

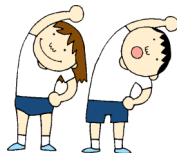
Beachcombers
