A MESSAGE FROM YOUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



After a long day, I found myself in the checkout line of a busy grocery store. Around me, the rhythmic beeps of scanners punctuated the shuffle of carts, while nearby, friends exchanged the familiar, half-hearted promise to “grab lunch soon”—a well-meaning refrain rarely fulfilled. In the next lane, an elderly gentleman was telling who I can only assume was his very young grandchild that when they got home, he’d “buy that wart off of her.” I was utterly flummoxed, positively befuddled, and completely nonplussed—what on earth was this tomfoolery unfolding in the sacred ten-items-or-less express lane? 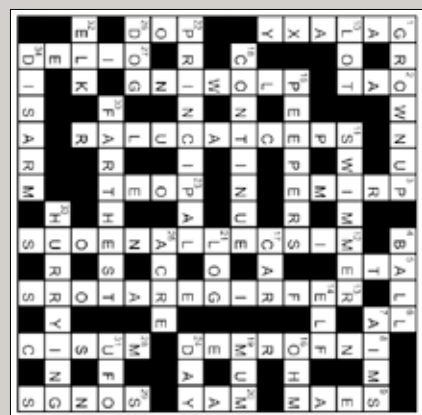
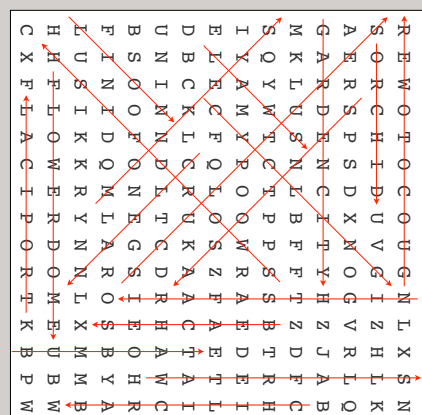

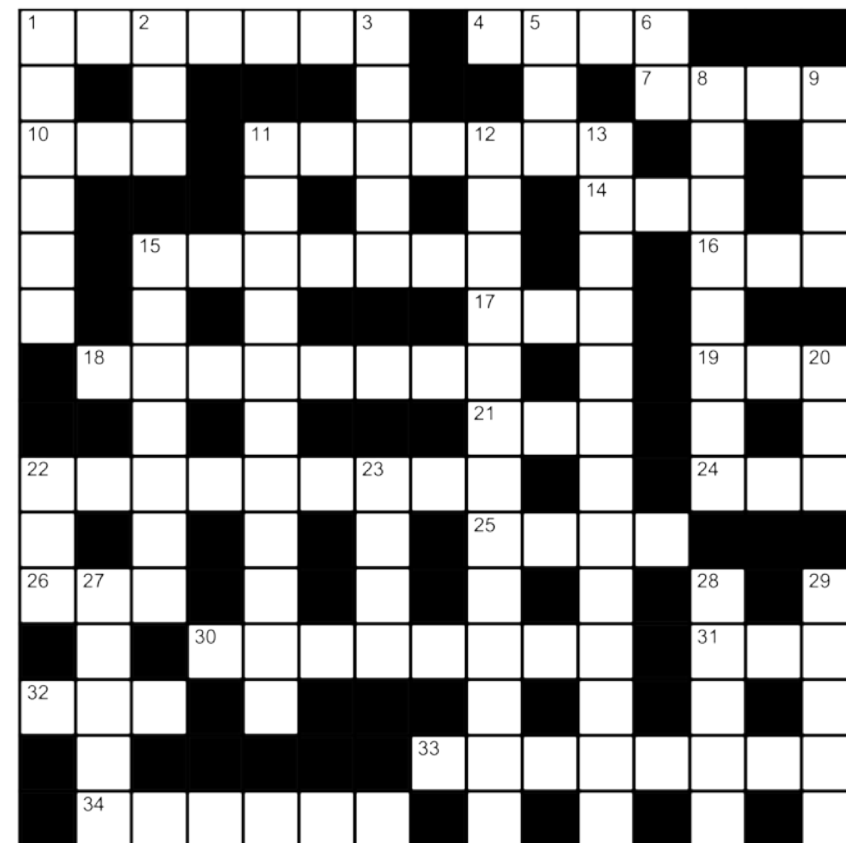
