Unless otherwise specified, prices shown do NOT include applicable HST.

The following format and content of the price list has been stipulated by the Bereavement Authority of Ontario and is required to be posted by all bereavement licensees.

MINIMUM SERVICES FOR DIRECT CREMATION

The Minimum Services charge represents the minimum non-declinable services required to facilitate the disposition of a deceased person by direct cremation.

This minimum service charge is applicable to every family we serve and includes transferring the Deceased from the place of death (or Coroner's Office, hospital, airport, etc.) to our holding room, where the Deceased will be placed in a casket* of your choosing and securely held until the necessary documentation is completed for cremation. Once the required documentation is ready (i.e., death has been registered and the Coroner's Certificate for cremation has been obtained), the Deceased is transported in a service van or SUV to the crematorium at the earliest practicable opportunity or at a scheduled time, as applicable.

Additional fees may apply for mileage beyond 60 km.

What is NOT included in the above Minimum Services charge:

- any supplies, such as a casket, outer burial container, urn, etc.
- any additional services that may be selected.
- additional mileage fees beyond 60 km.
- additional charges for residential transfers which always require 2 Staff Members.
- additional charges for hospital/hospice/LTC transfer which require 2 Staff Members.
- pacemaker / radioactive implant removal, as applicable
- applicable taxes (HST)
- disbursements to be paid to third parties on your behalf, such as the crematorium fee, coroner's fee, death registration fee, etc. (as described on page 8)

DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES AND FEES

Any services marked with an asterisk (*) are the minimum services required to carry out a direct cremation.

*** Professional and staff services (for Minimum Services)..... \$380.00**

Professional consultation with licensed personnel, including but not limited to expert advice on options to meet your needs, drafting notices, and advice regarding possible government benefits. Coordination of all activities before, during and after they have been provided by us, and those provided by third-party suppliers, such as the cemetery, crematorium, and media outlets (death notices). Also included are overhead expenses such as maintenance and utilities, accounting and office administration, insurance and 24-hour access to emergency assistance.

*** Documentation..... \$280.00**

Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate, cremation application or interment permission form. Third-party fees charged for these documents are not included and are itemized under Disbursements. We also provide 11 Proof of Death certificates for estate settlement purposes. Proof of Death certificates are provided to the deceased's authorized representative as a service only and are not a legal government document; however, they are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes. Includes preparation of CPP application(s).

*** Facilities for preparation/shelter..... \$370.00**

A secure, private, and climate-controlled room used to prepare and/or shelter the body until the time of cremation. The body is checked for personal effects (which will be returned to the authorized representative, unless otherwise instructed) and placed into the cremation container / casket. Identification may also take place in this room. If the body is to be held in our facility beyond a period of 2 days, a daily body storage fee of \$75.00 will apply.

TRANSPORTATION

*** Initial transfer of the Deceased..... \$350.00**

Customized vehicle, trained Staff and specialized equipment used to transfer the deceased into our care from the place of death or Coroner's Office, hospital, airport, etc. Additional mileage fees apply beyond 60 km.

*** Administration vehicle.....\$ 100.00**

General duty vehicle used to register the death, make off-site arrangements, etc.

*** Final transfer of Cremated Remains**

Vehicle and Staff to transfer the cremated remains from the crematorium.

***Using a service van or SUV..... \$220.00**

Additional mileage.....\$ 2.20 / km.

Charge per kilometer (one way) for use of any vehicle over a 60 km radius.

OTHER SERVICES AND SUPPLIES

These "Other Services and Supplies" are just that – Services and Supplies that may or may not be applicable to your situation and circumstances. These are the additional Services and Supplies that Wareing Cremation Services Inc. is able to provide, or may be required to provide in certain circumstances.

Additional mileage.....\$2.20 / km.

Mileage travelled beyond 60km will be charged at the rate of \$2.20 / km.

*** Removal of pacemakers or other implants**.....\$ 100.00

This procedure is mandatory prior to cremating a body that has a pacemaker or other implant and must be carried out by a licensed funeral director. Includes disposal of device. If a person was undergoing brachytherapy (radioactive theraseeds) or radioisotope treatments before death, it is possible that the deceased may not be able to be cremated; please inquire for more information.

Body Pouch.....\$ 65.00

A body pouch may be required for sanitation and safety purposes while transferring the deceased.

Residential and Hospital Transfers requiring 2 Staff members.....\$ 200.00

Some hospitals have placed restrictions on us that require 2 Staff members to attend when transferring the deceased into care; attending a private residence/public venue for transfer of the deceased into care will always require 2 Staff members; a deceased individual being transferred into care whose weight and/or body dimensions exceed the dimensions of our regular cremation container (those dimensions are listed in this complete price list) will always require 2 Staff members.

Identification of the Deceased in our Hold Room.....\$150.00

Understand that this is not "a visitation". Identification would be made by an immediate family member (or designate) in our climate-controlled hold room. The Deceased is not embalmed and their appearance has not been enhanced cosmetically; the Deceased is simply shrouded for identification purposes.

Refundable Deposit for Cremated Remains.....\$ 350.00

When human remains are to be cremated, payment of a refundable deposit may be required. If the cremated remains are not claimed within one year of the cremation, the deposit may be used to inter the cremated remains in common ground in a cemetery of the funeral home's choosing. If the cremated remains are claimed before they are interred, the deposit will be refunded.

Additional Proof of Death Certificates – each additional PODC\$25.00

Wareing Cremation Services Inc. provides 11 Proof of Death Certificates initially; this charge is for additional Certificates after the initial 11 provided.

Memorial Cards...minimum order of 50 Cards.....\$ 2.00 per card

Card stock, four-sided Memorial Card, created with family and professionally printed. There is no additional set up fee.

Thank You Cards - 4 designs to choose from; 25 cards/envelopes in each pkg.....\$17.00

Register Books - several beautiful styles to choose from – each book costs.....\$ 35.00

Jewellery - We offer a selection of pendants, bracelets and key chains

DISBURSEMENTS

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by the Transfer Service, in this particular case that would be Wareing Cremation Services Inc., to third party providers.

Any prices quoted in this section are subject to change without notice.

Such items include but are not limited to:

Cremation fee.....\$ 585.00

This fee is charged by the Holy Cross C.C.C. for the cremation of the body – adult up to 300 lbs.

There is a different fee for cremation of persons over 300 lbs.; for infants; for children.

The fees vary by crematorium.

Coroner's fee..... \$75.00

This is a Provincially set fee charged by a Coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation or alternative disposition or 'Out of Province' shipping to take place.

Municipal death registration fee.....\$ 20.00

This is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death on behalf of the Province of Ontario. The municipality issues a burial permit, then forwards the registration documents to the Office of the Registrar General in Thunder Bay.

BAO Consumer Protection Fee..... \$ 30.00

Media notices..... Price varies

These are charges for death notices in newspapers, or other media outlets.

The charge will be determined by the chosen media source based on the length of the death notice, their newspaper distribution area, etc.

*Wareing Cremation Services does not charge for assistance with composition or submission to the chosen media source, or for time commitment to proofing, and follow up for approval to print.

Wareing Cremation Services website for Obituary.....no extra charge

Wareing Cremation Services is pleased to offer our Families the opportunity to have their loved One's Obituary (which we will assist in composing if your family wishes) and photo included on our webpage (wareingcremation.ca).

Every Obituary posted has the ability to receive messages of remembrance and condolence.

CASKETS

The following caskets listed are those generally available. Additional options are absolutely available upon request. ***Unless otherwise noted, all caskets listed are standard adult size.***

Minimum requirements for a casket:

For Cremation: A body must be presented to the crematorium in a rigid, leak-proof casket that is made of a combustible material, such as wood or cardboard. Caskets containing non-flammable, hazardous material or chlorinated or fiber-reinforced plastic, other than incidental metal, cannot be used for cremation.

We offer a selection of cremation containers and caskets that are suitable for cremation. Victoriaville and co. have many caskets, with different price point, that can be provided if the family would want to choose a casket rather than a cremation container.

Wareing Cremation Services best practice dictates that we will not accept cremation containers or caskets from other sources that a family would choose and/or provide. We cannot ensure that these would meet the criteria, or that they are well constructed.

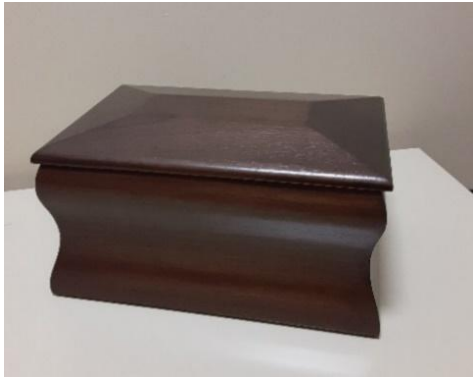
URNS and KEEPSAKE URNS

You are not required to purchase an Urn, or a keepsake urn. When a body is cremated, the remaining Cremated Remains will be presented in a box that is suitable for interment or scattering as is.

If the Urn is to be placed in a columbarium niche at a Cemetery, you must make sure the Urn you select will fit. For this very reason, Paul Wareing or Barb Wareing discusses place of interment with you.

Best practice dictates that Wareing Cremation Services will not transfer cremated remains into Urns, keepsakes, or jewellery sourced by families from other companies.

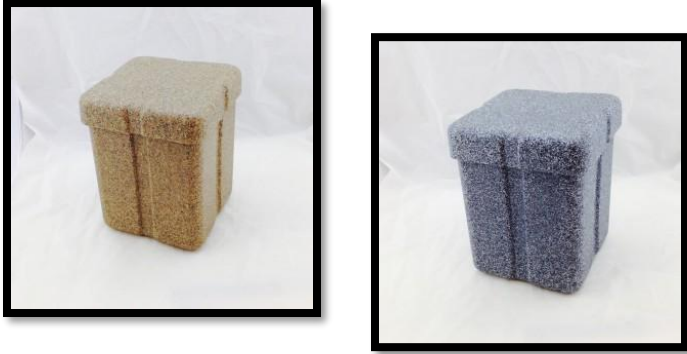
URN VAULTS

Outer burial containers listed below are Standard adult size Vaults, and an Oversize Vault which is available to accommodate plus-size Urns, Companion Urns, or multiple Urns.

You are not required to purchase an Urn Vault. A cemetery operator may designate a specific area in the cemetery where vaults are required; however, the operator must have another area where vaults are not required, so that consumers have a choice.

PAYMENT, FINANCING & FUNDING

For services at time of death:

Payment is due at the time of signing the contract, beyond which interest will be charged at a rate of 2% per month, which is (equivalent to 26.82 per annum). Payment may be made by cash, cheque, Debit, Mastercard or VISA.

Financial assistance for burial and cremation services is available through various governmental agencies, to those who qualify.

Pre-payment in advance of need:

For services that are being arranged pre-need, we offer one funding option when prepaying services or supplies:

Insurance: You may purchase an Annuity policy through us, where the proceeds of the annuity policy will be used to pay for the services or supplies at the time they are delivered. Payment may be made by credit card or cheque for single payments. The policy is held in your name and assigned to the Transfer Service Operator. Terms and conditions and cancellation policies are set by the Insurance Company.

Guarantee: When paid in full in accordance with the payment terms set out in the prepaid contract, the prepaid contract is guaranteed. The total payment(s) made plus interest / growth earned will be applied to the future price of the services and supplies. If the total payment(s) plus interest / growth earned are insufficient to cover the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies, we will absorb the difference as a loss. Any funds in excess of the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies will be returned or applied toward additional services, supplies and disbursements purchased at the time of need, as applicable. Conditions apply. Any changes to the prepaid contract may result in the prepaid contract being null and void and a new contract being executed with current pricing at the time changes are made.
