The following format and content of the price list has been stipulated by the Bereavement Authority of Ontario and is required to be posted by all bereavement licensees.

MINIMUM SERVICES FOR DIRECT CREMATION

The Minimum Services charge represents the minimum non-declinable services required to facilitate the disposition of a deceased person by direct cremation.

This minimum service charge is applicable to every family we serve and includes transferring the Deceased from the place of death (or Coroner's Office, hospital, airport, etc.) to our holding room, where the Deceased will be placed in a casket* of your choosing and securely held until the necessary documentation is completed for cremation. Once the required documentation is ready (i.e., death has been registered and the Coroner's Certificate for cremation has been obtained), the Deceased is transported in a service van or SUV to the crematorium at the earliest practicable opportunity or at a scheduled time, as applicable.

Additional fees may apply for mileage beyond 60 km.

What is NOT included in the above Minimum Services charge:

- any supplies, such as a casket, outer burial container, urn, etc.
- any additional services that may be selected.
- additional mileage fees beyond 60 km.
- additional charges for residential transfers which always require 2 Staff Members.
- additional charges for hospital/hospice/LTC transfer which require 2 Staff Members.
- pacemaker / radioactive implant removal, as applicable
- applicable taxes (HST)
- disbursements to be paid to third parties on your behalf, such as the crematorium fee, coroner's fee, death registration fee, etc. (as described on page 8)

DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES AND FEES

Any services marked with an asterisk (*) are the minimum services required to carry out a direct cremation.

* Professional and staff services (for Minimum Services)
* Documentation
* Facilities for preparation/shelter
* Initial transfer of the Deceased
* Administration vehicle
* Final transfer of Cremated Remains Vehicle and Staff to transfer the cremated remains from the crematorium. *Using a service van or SUV
Additional mileage\$ 2.20 / km. Charge per kilometer (one way) for use of any vehicle over a 60 km radius.

OTHER SERVICES AND SUPPLIES

These "Other Services and Supplies" are just that – Services and Supplies that may or may not be applicable to your situation and circumstances. These are the additional Services and Supplies that Wareing Cremation Services Inc. is able to provide, or may be required to provide in certain circumstances.

Additional mileage\$2.20 / km.
Mileage travelled beyond 60km will be charged at the rate of \$2.20 / km.
* Removal of pacemakers or other implants
This procedure is mandatory prior to cremating a body that has a pacemaker or other implant and must be carried out by a licensed funeral director. Includes disposal of device. If a person was undergoing
brachytherapy (radioactive theraseeds) or radioisotope treatments before death, it is possible that the
deceased may not be able to be cremated; please inquire for more information.
Body Pouch
A body pouch may be required for sanitation and safety purposes while transferring the deceased.
Residential and Hospital Transfers requiring 2 Staff members
Some hospitals have placed restrictions on us that require 2 Staff members to attend when transferring the deceased into care; attending a private residence/public venue
for transfer of the deceased into care will always require 2 Staff members;
a deceased individual being transferred into care whose weight and/or body dimensions
exceed the dimensions of our regular cremation container (those dimensions are listed
in this complete price list) will always require 2 Staff members.
Identification of the Deceased in our Hold Room\$150.00
Understand that this is not "a visitation". Identification would be made by an immediate
family member (or designate) in our climate-controlled hold room. The Deceased is not embalmed and their appearance has not been enhanced cosmetically; the
Deceased is simply shrouded for identification purposes.
Refundable Deposit for Cremated Remains\$350.00
When human remains are to be cremated, payment of a refundable deposit may be required. If the
cremated remains are not claimed within one year of the cremation, the deposit may be used to inter
the cremated remains in common ground in a cemetery of the funeral home's choosing. If the cremated remains are claimed before they are interred, the deposit will be refunded.

DISBURSEMENTS

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by the Transfer Service, in this particular case that would be Wareing Cremation Services Inc., to third party providers.

Any prices quoted in this section are subject to change without notice.

Such items include but are not limited to:

Cremation fee. This fee is charged by the Holy Cross C.C.C. for the cremation of the body – adult up to 300 lbs. There is a different fee for cremation of persons over 300 lbs.; for infants; for children. The fees vary by crematorium.	\$ 585.00
Coroner's fee	\$75.00
Municipal death registration fee. This is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death on behalf of the Province of Ontario. The municipality issues a burial permit, then forwards the registration documents to the Office of the Registrar General in Thunder Bay.	\$ 20.00

BAO Consumer Protection Fee. \$30.00

Media notices Price varies

These are charges for death notices in newspapers, or other media outlets.

The charge will be determined by the chosen media source based on the length of the death notice, their newspaper distribution area, etc.

*Wareing Cremation Services does not charge for assistance with composition or submission to the chosen media source, or for time commitment to proofing, and follow up for approval to print.

CASKETS

The following caskets listed are those generally available. Additional options are absolutely available upon request. *Unless otherwise noted, all caskets listed are standard adult size.*

Minimum requirements for a casket:

<u>For Cremation</u>: A body must be presented to the crematorium in a rigid, leak-proof casket that is made of a combustible material, such as wood or cardboard. Caskets containing non-flammable, hazardous material or chlorinated or fiber-reinforced plastic, other than incidental metal, cannot be used for cremation.

We offer a selection of cremation containers and caskets that are suitable for cremation. Victoriaville and co. have many caskets, with different price point, that can be provided if the family would want to choose a casket rather than a cremation container.

Wareing Cremation Services best practice dictates that we will not accept cremation containers or caskets from other sources that a family would choose and/or provide. We cannot ensure that these would meet the criteria, or that they are well constructed.


URN VAULTS

You are not required to purchase an Urn Vault. A cemetery operator may designate a specific area in the cemetery where vaults are required; however, the operator must have another area where vaults are not required, so that consumers have a choice.

PAYMENT, FINANCING & FUNDING

For services at time of death:

Payment is due at the time of signing the contract, beyond which interest will be charged at a rate of 2% per month, which is (equivalent to 26.82 per annum). Payment may be made by cash, cheque, Debit, Mastercard or VISA.

Financial assistance for burial and cremation services is available through various governmental agencies, to those who qualify.

Pre-payment in advance of need:

For services that are being arranged pre-need, we offer one funding option when prepaying services or supplies:

Insurance: You may purchase an Annuity policy through us, where the proceeds of the annuity policy will be used to pay for the services or supplies at the time they are delivered. Payment may be made by credit card or cheque for single payments. The policy is held in your name and assigned to the Transfer Service Operator. Terms and conditions and cancellation policies are set by the Insurance Company.

<u>Guarantee</u>: When paid in full in accordance with the payment terms set out in the prepaid contract, the prepaid contract is guaranteed. The total payment(s) made plus interest / growth earned will be applied to the future price of the services and supplies. If the total payment(s) plus interest / growth earned are insufficient to cover the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies, we will absorb the difference as a loss. Any funds in excess of the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies will be returned or applied toward additional services, supplies and disbursements purchased at the time of need, as applicable. Conditions apply. Any changes to the prepaid contract may result in the prepaid contract being null and void and a new contract being executed with current pricing at the time changes are made.
