Special Announcement from the Lakeland Power Co-op Board of Directors

In a world of rising costs, the Lakeland Power Co-op Board of Directors are pleased to announce that a moratorium has been placed on the \$5.50 Deposit Reserve (DR) Tariff and the \$5.50 Brushing Tariff, effective October 1, 2025.

Lakeland Power Co-op sets its Distribution Tariff (DT) based on breaker sizes to cover the operations and maintenance of your electrical system. The current DT was established in 2010 and has not changed since that time. To ensure transparency with the membership, the Board introduced the Deposit Reserve (\$15) and Brushing (\$20) Tariffs to help cover the costs of these specific services.

In 2013, both tariffs were reduced to \$5.50 for each service.

As a cooperative, the Board listens carefully to its members and values the feedback and input we receive.

After thoughtful consideration, the Board believes that the Co-op is in a strong financial position to pass

these savings on to its members, and this moratorium reflects that commitment.

This decision highlights one of the key benefits of being part of a cooperative — members working together for mutual benefit.

The Board will continue to monitor these expenditures moving forward, as brushing and pole replacement remain essential components of maintaining a safe and reliable electrical distribution system.

Additionally, when clearing snow, please take note of where it is being placed throughout the season. Snow should not be pushed or piled within our Right of Way areas, as this can block access to the transformer pole and power poles both in your yard and along the mainline.

Your cooperation helps our linemen work safely and restore power more quickly when needed. Thank you for your help in keeping our system reliable and accessible this winter.
