



Access to Transformer Poles

Our linemen had to replace a transformer on December 20 in the bitter cold and due to debris around the transformer pole, access was extremely difficult.



It is very important to ensure the area up to and around your transformer pole has the snow plowed and is free of vehicles and debris to ensure our equipment has sufficient access in the event of a power outage and work needs to be done to your transformer or it needs to be replaced.

Alberta Government Affordability Relief Measures

Electricity rebates will be extended until April 2023. For January and February you will see a \$75 rebate on your power bills and for March and April the rebate will be \$25.

For the months of January, February and March 2023, members on the RRO (Regulated Rate Option) will be charged an RRO cap of 13.5 cents per kilowatt hour on your energy.

The difference in the set RRO, as per Lakeland Power Co-op's RRO price setting plan, and the Government of Alberta 13.5 cent RRO cap for these three months will be deferred and will be repaid by all members on the RRO over 21 months (April 2023 to December 2024).
