# Twin Disciplines: To Abide, To Abstain

There are two inseparable and invincible Christian disciplines: to abide and to abstain.

John 15:5 ESV

5 I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever <u>abides in me</u> and <u>I in him</u>, he it is that <u>bears much fruit</u>, for <u>apart from me</u> you <u>can do nothing</u>.

1 Peter 2:11 ESV

11 Beloved, I urge you as sojourners and exiles <u>to abstain from the passions of the flesh</u>, which <u>wage war</u> <u>against your soul</u>.

The more you abide, the more you want to abstain. The more you abide, the more you hate what you're abstaining from.

This is the work of sanctification: obeying more and sinning less.

### Psalm 101:1-2 ESV A Psalm of David.

- 1 I will sing of steadfast love and justice; to you, O LORD, I will make music.
- 2 I <u>will ponder the way</u> that is <u>blameless</u>. Oh <u>when will you come to me</u>? I will walk with integrity of heart within my house;
  - 2 Corinthians 6:16-18 ESV
  - 16 What agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; as God said, "I will make my dwelling among them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.
  - 17 Therefore <u>go out from their midst</u>, and <u>be separate from them</u>, says the Lord, and <u>touch no unclean</u> <u>thing</u>; then <u>I will welcome you</u>,
  - 18 and I will be a father to you, and you shall be sons and daughters to me, says the Lord Almighty."

### Psalm 101:3-4 ESV

- 3 <u>I will not set before my eyes</u> anything <u>that is worthless</u>. <u>I hate the work</u> of those <u>who fall away</u>; it <u>shall not cling</u> to me.
- 4 A perverse heart shall be far from me; I will know nothing of evil.

Matthew 5:29-30 ESV

- 29 If your right eye <u>causes you to sin</u>, <u>tear it out</u> and <u>throw it away</u>. For <u>it is better</u> that you <u>lose one of your members</u> than that <u>your whole body</u> be <u>thrown into hell</u>.
- 30 And if your right hand <u>causes you to sin</u>, <u>cut it off</u> and <u>throw it away</u>. For <u>it is better</u> that you <u>lose one</u> <u>of your members</u> than that <u>your whole body</u> <u>go into hell</u>.

#### Psalm 101:5-8 ESV

- 5 Whoever <u>slanders his neighbor secretly</u> I <u>will destroy</u>. Whoever <u>has a haughty look</u> and <u>an arrogant heart</u> I will not endure.
- 6 <u>I will look with favor</u> on the faithful in the land, that they may dwell with me; he who walks in the way that is blameless shall minister to me.
- 7 No one who practices deceit shall dwell in my house; no one who utters lies shall continue before my eyes.
  8 Morning by morning I will destroy all the wicked in the land, cutting off all the evildoers from the city of the LORD.
  - 1 Corinthians 15:33 ESV
  - 33 <u>Do not be deceived</u>: "<u>Bad company ruins good morals</u>."

Hebrews 3:12-14 ESV

- 12 <u>Take care</u>, brothers, <u>lest there be in any of you</u> an <u>evil</u>, <u>unbelieving heart</u>, <u>leading you to fall away from</u> the living God.
- 13 But <u>exhort one another every day</u>, as long as it is called "today," that <u>none of you may be hardened</u> by <u>the deceitfulness of sin</u>.
- 14 For we have come to share in Christ, if indeed we hold our original confidence firm to the end.
- 2 Timothy 2:19-22 ESV
- 19 But <u>God's firm foundation stands</u>, bearing this seal: "The Lord <u>knows those who are his</u>," and, "Let everyone <u>who names the name of the Lord</u> <u>depart from iniquity."</u>
- 20 Now <u>in a great house</u> there are <u>not only vessels of gold</u> and <u>silver</u> but also <u>of wood</u> and <u>clay</u>, some <u>for honorable use</u>, some <u>for dishonorable</u>.
- 21 Therefore, if anyone <u>cleanses himself</u> from <u>what is dishonorable</u>, he <u>will be</u> a <u>vessel for honorable use</u>, <u>set apart as holy</u>, <u>useful to the master</u> of the house, <u>ready</u> for <u>every good work</u>.
- 22 So <u>flee youthful passions</u> and <u>pursue righteousness</u>, faith, love, and peace, <u>along with those</u> who <u>call</u> <u>on the Lord</u> <u>from a pure heart</u>.

## What about?

Matthew 15:1-2 ESV

- 1 Then Pharisees and scribes came to Jesus from Jerusalem and said,
- 2 "Why do your disciples break the tradition of the elders? For they do not wash their hands when they eat."

Matthew 15:10-11 ESV

10 And he called the people to him and said to them, "Hear and understand:

11 it is not what goes into the mouth that defiles a person, but what comes out of the mouth; this defiles a person."

Matthew 15:17-20 ESV

- 17 Do you not see that whatever goes into the mouth passes into the stomach and is expelled?
- 18 But what comes out of the mouth proceeds from the heart, and this defiles a person.
- 19 For out of the heart come evil thoughts, murder, adultery, sexual immorality, theft, false witness, slander.
- 20 These are what defile a person. But to eat with unwashed hands does not defile anyone."
