A Strong Delusion

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• The strong delusion, since the beginning of time, is the denial of God's existence, His rule over all and His coming judgment coupled with the denial of our accountability.

Proverbs 9:10 ESV

10 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is insight.

Proverbs 16:6 ESV

6 ... by the fear of the LORD one turns away from evil.

Judges 21:25 ESV

25 In those days there was no king in Israel. Everyone did what was right in his own eyes.

Jeremiah 9:1-24 ESV

- 1 Oh that my head were waters, and my eyes a fountain of tears, that I might weep day and night for the slain of the daughter of my people!
- 2 Oh that I had in the desert a travelers' lodging place, that <u>I might leave my people</u> and <u>go away from them!</u> For <u>they are all adulterers</u>, a company of <u>treacherous men</u>.
- 3 They <u>bend their tongue like a bow</u>; <u>falsehood</u> and not truth <u>has grown strong in the land</u>; for <u>they proceed</u> from evil to evil, and **THEY DO NOT KNOW ME**, declares the LORD.
- 4 Let everyone <u>beware of his neighbor</u>, and <u>put no trust in any brother</u>, for <u>every brother is a deceiver</u>, and <u>every neighbor</u> goes about <u>as a slanderer</u>.
- 5 Everyone deceives his neighbor, and no one speaks the truth; they have taught their tongue to speak lies; they weary themselves committing iniquity.
 - "...over the last three years, she [Bari Weiss, New York Times journalist] says she has been 'the subject of constant bullying by colleagues who disagree with my views. They have called me a Nazi and a racist ... [and] publicly smear me as a liar and a bigot on Twitter with no fear that harassing me will be met with appropriate action. They never are.'"

Romans 1:18-32 ESV

- 18 For <u>the wrath of God is revealed</u> from heaven <u>against all ungodliness</u> and <u>unrighteousness of men</u>, who <u>by their unrighteousness</u> <u>suppress the truth</u>.
- 19 For what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them.
- 20 For his invisible attributes, namely, <u>his eternal power</u> and <u>divine nature</u>, <u>have been clearly perceived</u>, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So <u>they are without excuse</u>.
- 21 For <u>although they knew God</u>, they <u>did not honor him as God</u> or <u>give thanks to him</u>, but <u>they became</u> <u>futile in their thinking</u>, and <u>their foolish hearts were darkened</u>.
- 22 Claiming to be wise, they became fools,
- 23 and exchanged the glory of the immortal God for images resembling mortal man and birds and animals and creeping things.
- 24 Therefore <u>God gave them up</u> in the lusts of their hearts <u>to impurity</u>, to the dishonoring of their bodies among themselves,
- 25 because they exchanged the truth about God for a lie and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever! Amen.
- 26 For this reason <u>God gave them up</u> to <u>dishonorable passions</u>. For their women exchanged natural relations for those that are contrary to nature;
- 27 and the men likewise gave up natural relations with women and were consumed with passion for one another, men committing shameless acts with men and receiving in themselves the due penalty for their error.
- 28 And since they <u>did not see fit to acknowledge God</u>, God <u>gave them up to a debased mind</u> to do what ought not to be done.
- 29 They were <u>filled with all manner of unrighteousness</u>, <u>evil</u>, <u>covetousness</u>, <u>malice</u>. They are full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, maliciousness. They are gossips,
- 30 slanderers, haters of God, insolent, haughty, boastful, inventors of evil, disobedient to parents, 31 foolish, faithless, heartless, ruthless.
- 32 <u>Though they know God's righteous decree</u> that those <u>who practice such things deserve to die</u>, they not only do them but give approval to those who practice them.

Isaiah 5:20-21 ESV

20 <u>Woe to those</u> who <u>call evil good</u> and <u>good evil</u>, who <u>put darkness for light</u> and <u>light for darkness</u>, who put bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter!

21 Woe to those who are wise in their own eyes, and shrewd in their own sight!

A Fiery Test

Jeremiah 9:1-24 ESV

6 <u>Heaping oppression upon oppression</u>, and <u>deceit upon deceit</u>, <u>THEY REFUSE TO KNOW ME</u>, declares the LORD. 7 Therefore thus says the LORD of hosts: "Behold, <u>I will refine them</u> and <u>test them</u>, for <u>what else can I do</u>, because of my people?

- refine (tsaraph) fuse metal, smelt, melt, purge away, refine, test, try, prove
- <u>test</u> (bachan) examine, try, prove, test, make a trial
- Before reaching an apex of judgment, God brings fiery trials to:
 - o give one more chance for repentance
 - to prove what is in the hearts

Deuteronomy 8:2 ESV

2 And you shall remember the whole way that the LORD your God has led you these forty years in the wilderness, that he might humble you, <u>testing you to know what was in your heart</u>, whether <u>you would keep his commandments</u> or <u>not</u>.

2 Thessalonians 2:9-12 ESV

9 The <u>coming of the lawless one</u> is <u>by the activity of Satan with all power</u> and <u>false signs</u> and <u>wonders</u>, 10 and <u>with all wicked deception</u> for those <u>who are perishing</u>, because <u>they refused to love the truth</u> and <u>so be saved</u>.

11 Therefore <u>God sends them a strong delusion</u>, so that <u>they may believe what is false</u>, 12 in order that <u>all may be condemned</u> who <u>did not believe the truth</u> but had <u>pleasure in unrighteousness</u>.

An Apex Of Judgment

Jeremiah 9:1-24 ESV

- 8 <u>Their tongue is a deadly arrow</u>; it <u>speaks deceitfully</u>; with his mouth each speaks peace to his neighbor, but <u>in his heart</u> he <u>plans an ambush</u> for him.
- 9 <u>Shall I not punish them for these things?</u> declares the LORD, and <u>shall I not avenge myself</u> on <u>a nation such as this?</u>
 - To say that God does not bring judgment on nations for their sin, and that God does not bring judgment through natural disasters, wars, conflict, poverty and hunger, is to deny that the Bible is true and is the very fruit of the great delusion.

Jeremiah 9:1-24 ESV

- 10 "I will <u>take up weeping</u> and <u>wailing</u> for the mountains, and <u>a lamentation</u> for the pastures of the wilderness, because <u>they are laid waste</u> so that <u>no one passes through</u>, and <u>the lowing of cattle</u> is <u>not heard</u>; both the birds of the air and the beasts <u>have fled</u> and <u>are gone</u>.
- 11 I will <u>make Jerusalem a heap of ruins</u>, a lair of jackals, and <u>I will make the cities</u> of Judah <u>a desolation</u>, <u>without inhabitant</u>."
- 12 <u>Who is the man so wise</u> that <u>he can understand this</u>? To whom has the mouth of the LORD spoken, that he may declare it? <u>Why is the land ruined</u> and <u>laid waste like a wilderness</u>, so that no one passes through?
- 13 And the LORD says: "Because they have forsaken my law that I set before them, and have not obeyed my voice or walked in accord with it,
- 14 but have <u>stubbornly followed their own hearts</u> and <u>have gone after the Baals</u>, as their fathers taught them.
- 15 Therefore thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: Behold, <u>I will feed this people with bitter food</u>, and <u>give them poisonous water</u> to drink.
- 16 I will scatter them among the nations whom neither they nor their fathers have known, and <u>I will send the sword after them</u>, <u>until I have consumed them</u>."
- 17 Thus says the LORD of hosts: "Consider, and call for the mourning women to come; send for the skillful women to come;
- 18 let them make haste and raise a wailing over us, that our eyes may run down with tears and our eyelids flow with water.
- 19 For a sound of wailing is heard from Zion: 'How we are ruined! We are utterly shamed, because we have left the land, because they have cast down our dwellings.'"
- 20 Hear, O women, the word of the LORD, and let your ear receive the word of his mouth; teach to your daughters a lament, and each to her neighbor a dirge.
- 21 For <u>death has come up into our windows</u>; it has <u>entered our palaces</u>, cutting off the children from the streets and the young men from the squares.
- 22 Speak: "Thus declares the LORD, '<u>The dead bodies of men shall fall</u> like <u>dung upon the open field</u>, like <u>sheaves</u> <u>after the reaper</u>, and <u>none shall gather them</u>.""

The Only Hope

Jeremiah 9:1-24 ESV

23 Thus says the LORD: "Let not the wise man boast in his wisdom, let not the mighty man boast in his might, let not the rich man boast in his riches,

24 but <u>let him who boasts boast in this</u>, that <u>he understands</u> and <u>knows me</u>, that <u>l am the LORD</u> who <u>practices</u> <u>steadfast love</u>, <u>justice</u>, and <u>righteousness in the earth</u>. For in these things I delight, declares the LORD."

Jeremiah 31:27-34 ESV

- 27 Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will sow the house of Israel and the house of Judah with the seed of man and the seed of beast.
- 28 And it shall come to pass that <u>as I have watched over them</u> to <u>pluck up</u> and <u>break down</u>, to <u>overthrow</u>, <u>destroy</u>, and <u>bring harm</u>, so <u>I will watch over them</u> to <u>build</u> and to <u>plant</u>, declares the LORD.
- 29 In those days they shall no longer say: "'The fathers have eaten sour grapes, and the children's teeth are set on edge.'
- 30 But everyone shall die for his own iniquity. Each man who eats sour grapes, his teeth shall be set on edge.
- 31 Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah,
- 32 not like the covenant that I made with their fathers on the day when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, my covenant that they broke, though I was their husband, declares the LORD.
- 33 For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the LORD: <u>I will put my law within them</u>, and <u>I will write it on their hearts</u>. And <u>I will be their God</u>, and <u>they shall be my people</u>.

 34 And no longer shall each one teach his neighbor and each his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for <u>they shall all know me</u>, <u>from the least of them</u> <u>to the greatest</u>, declares the LORD. For <u>I will forgive their iniquity</u>, and I will remember their sin no more."
