WE LIVE IN A CRUEL AND BLOODY BATTLEFIELD WHERE SIN IS CROUCHING AND SATAN IS PROWLING

- 2 Chronicles 20:1-2 ESV
- 1 After this the Moabites and Ammonites, and with them some of the Meunites, came against Jehoshaphat for hattle
- 2 Some men came and told Jehoshaphat, "A great multitude is coming against you from Edom, from beyond the sea; and, behold, they are in Hazazon-tamar" (that is, Engedi).

Ephesians 6:12 ESV

12 For we <u>do not wrestle against flesh and blood</u>, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, <u>against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places</u>.

THERE CAN BE ONLY ONE REACTION TO FEAR

- 2 Chronicles 20:3 ESV
- 3 Then Jehoshaphat was afraid and set his face to seek the LORD, and proclaimed a fast throughout all Judah.

"So, first of all, let me assert my firm belief that the only thing we have to fear is fear itself—nameless, unreasoning, unjustified terror which paralyzes needed efforts to convert retreat into advance."

ESV "for God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and <u>self-control</u>."

CSB "For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but one of power, love, and <u>sound judgment</u>."

NASB "For God has not given us a spirit of timidity, but of power and love and <u>discipline</u>."

DON'T BECOME ISOLATED - ASSEMBLE WITH GOD'S PEOPLE

- 2 Chronicles 20:4 ESV
- 4 And <u>Judah assembled to seek help from the LORD</u>; from <u>all the cities</u> of Judah they <u>came to seek the LORD</u>. 5 And <u>Jehoshaphat stood in the assembly</u> of Judah and Jerusalem, <u>in the house of the LORD</u>, before the new court,

Nehemiah 4:17,19,20 ESV

17 Those who carried burdens were loaded in such a way that each <u>labored on the work with one hand</u> and <u>held his</u> <u>weapon with the other.</u>

19 And I said to the nobles and to the officials and to the rest of the people, "The <u>work is great</u> and <u>widely spread</u>, and we <u>are separated on the wall</u>, <u>far from one another</u>.

20 In the place where you hear the sound of the trumpet, rally to us there. Our God will fight for us.

Hebrews 10:24-25 ESV

24 And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works,

25 <u>not neglecting to meet together</u>, as is the habit of some, but <u>encouraging one another</u>, and <u>all the more as you see the Day drawing near</u>.

REMEMBER GOD'S SOVEREIGNTY

2 Chronicles 20:6 ESV

6 and said, "O LORD, God of our fathers, <u>are you not God in heaven?</u> You rule over all the kingdoms of the nations. <u>In your hand are power and might</u>, so that <u>none is able to withstand you</u>.

Jeremiah 32:17 ESV

17 Ah, Lord GOD! It is you who have made the heavens and the earth by your great power and by your outstretched arm! Nothing is too hard for you.

REMEMBER AND RECOUNT GOD'S MIRACLES

2 Chronicles 20:7 ESV

7 <u>Did you not</u>, our God, <u>drive out the inhabitants</u> of this land <u>before your people Israel</u>, and <u>give it forever</u> to <u>the descendants of Abraham your friend</u>?

Psalm 40:9-10 ESV

9 <u>I have told</u> the <u>glad news of deliverance</u> in <u>the great congregation</u>; behold, <u>I have not restrained my lips</u>, as you know, O LORD.

REMEMBER YOUR UTTER DEPENDENCE ON GOD

2 Chronicles 20:12 ESV

12 O our God, will you not execute judgment on them? For we are powerless against this great horde that is coming against us. We do not know what to do, but our eyes are on you."

John 15:5 ESV

5 ... apart from me you can do nothing.

Psalm 127:1 ESV

1 Unless the LORD builds the house, those who build it labor in vain. Unless the LORD watches over the city, the watchman stays awake in vain.

Matthew 7:21-23 ESV

21 "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.

DON'T RELY ON YOUR WISDOM OR PERSPECTIVE

2 Chronicles 20:12 ESV

12 O our God, will you not execute judgment on them? For we are powerless against this great horde that is coming against us. We do not know what to do, but our eyes are on you."

Proverbs 3:5-7 ESV

5 Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and <u>do not lean on your own understanding</u>.

6 <u>In all your ways acknowledge him</u>, and he will make straight your paths.

7 Be not wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD, and turn away from evil.

1 Corinthians 2:9-10 ESV

9 But, as it is written, "What no eye has seen, nor ear heard, nor the heart of man imagined, <u>what God has</u> <u>prepared</u> for <u>those who love him</u>"--

FIX YOUR EYES - GUARD WHAT YOU SEE AND HEAR

2 Chronicles 20:12 ESV

12 O our God, will you not execute judgment on them? For we are powerless against this great horde that is coming against us. We do not know what to do, but our eyes are on you."

Matthew 14:28-30 ESV

28 And Peter answered him, "Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water."

29 He said, "Come." So Peter got out of the boat and walked on the water and came to Jesus.

30 But <u>when he saw the wind</u>, he was afraid, and <u>beginning to sink</u> he cried out, "Lord, save me."

Hebrews 12:1-2 NASB

- 1 ...let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,
- 2 <u>fixing our eyes on Jesus</u>, the author and perfecter of faith, who <u>for the joy set before Him</u> <u>endured the cross</u>, <u>despising the shame</u>, and <u>has sat down</u> at the right hand of the throne of God.

LISTEN FOR GOD'S DIRECTION, BOTH INDIVIDUALLY AND CORPORATELY

- 2 Chronicles 20:13-14 ESV
- 13 Meanwhile all Judah stood before the LORD, with their little ones, their wives, and their children.
- 14 And the Spirit of the LORD came upon Jahaziel the son of Zechariah, son of Benaiah, son of Jeiel, son of Mattaniah, a Levite of the sons of Asaph, in the midst of the assembly.

James 1:5 NASB

5 But <u>if any of you lacks wisdom</u>, let him <u>ask of God</u>, who <u>gives to all generously</u> and <u>without reproach</u>, and <u>it will</u> <u>be given to him</u>.

- 1 Corinthians 12:7-11 ESV
- 7 <u>To each is given</u> the <u>manifestation of the Spirit</u> for <u>the common good</u>.
- 8 For to one is given through the Spirit <u>the utterance of wisdom</u>, and to another <u>the utterance of knowledge</u> according to the same Spirit,
- 9 to another <u>faith</u> by the same Spirit, to another <u>gifts of healing</u> by the one Spirit,
- 10 to another <u>the working of miracles</u>, to another <u>prophecy</u>, to another the ability to <u>distinguish between spirits</u>, to another <u>various kinds of tongues</u>, to another <u>the interpretation of tongues</u>.
- 11 All these are empowered by one and the same Spirit, who apportions to each one individually as he wills.

PRAYER IS WHERE THE WORK IS DONE AND THE BATTLE WON

- 2 Chronicles 20:15-20 ESV
- 15 And he said, "Listen, all Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem and King Jehoshaphat: Thus says the LORD to you, 'Do not be afraid and do not be dismayed at this great horde, for the battle is not yours but God's.
- 16 Tomorrow go down against them. Behold, they will come up by the ascent of Ziz. You will find them at the end of the valley, east of the wilderness of Jeruel.
- 17 You will not need to fight in this battle. Stand firm, hold your position, and see the salvation of the LORD on your behalf, O Judah and Jerusalem.' Do not be afraid and do not be dismayed. Tomorrow go out against them, and the LORD will be with you."
- 18 Then Jehoshaphat bowed his head with his face to the ground, and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem fell down before the LORD, worshiping the LORD.

19 And the Levites, of the Kohathites and the Korahites, stood up to praise the LORD, the God of Israel, with a very loud voice.

20 And they rose early in the morning and went out into the wilderness of Tekoa. And when they went out, Jehoshaphat stood and said, "Hear me, Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem! <u>Believe in the LORD your God</u>, and <u>you will be established</u>; believe his prophets, and you will succeed."

5 Commit your way to the LORD; trust in him, and he will act.

16 The heartfelt and persistent prayer of a righteous man <u>can accomplish much</u> [when put into action and made effective by God—<u>it is dynamic</u> and <u>can have tremendous power</u>].

BE QUICK TO LISTEN FOR GODLY COUNSEL

2 Chronicles 20:21 ESV

21 And when he had taken counsel with the people, he appointed those who were to sing to the LORD and praise him in holy attire, as they went before the army, and say, "Give thanks to the LORD, for his steadfast love endures forever."

Acts 6:3 ESV

3 Therefore, brothers, <u>pick out from among you</u> seven men of good repute, full of the Spirit and of wisdom, <u>whom</u> <u>we will appoint to this duty</u>.

PRAISE AND WORSHIP IS SPIRITUAL WARFARE

2 Chronicles 20:22 ESV

22 And when they began to sing and praise, the LORD set an ambush against the men of Ammon, Moab, and Mount Seir, who had come against Judah, so that they were routed.

23 For the men of Ammon and Moab rose against the inhabitants of Mount Seir, <u>devoting them to destruction</u>, and when <u>they had made an end of the inhabitants of Seir</u>, they <u>all helped to destroy one another</u>.

24 When Judah came to the watchtower of the wilderness, they looked toward the horde, and behold, there were dead bodies lying on the ground; <u>none had escaped</u>.

Acts 16:25-26 ESV

25 About midnight Paul and Silas were <u>praying</u> and <u>singing hymns to God</u>, and the prisoners were listening to them,

26 and <u>suddenly there was a great earthquake</u>, so that <u>the foundations of the prison were shaken</u>. And immediately <u>all the doors were opened</u>, and <u>everyone's bonds were unfastened</u>.

NEVER FAIL TO RETURN THANKS AND GLORY TO GOD

2 Chronicles 20:25-28 ESV

25 When Jehoshaphat and his people came to take their spoil, they found among them, in great numbers, goods, clothing, and precious things, which they took for themselves until they could carry no more. They were three days in taking the spoil, it was so much.

26 On the fourth day they assembled in the Valley of Beracah, for <u>there they blessed the LORD</u>. Therefore the name of that place has been called the Valley of Beracah to this day.

27 Then they returned, every man of Judah and Jerusalem, and Jehoshaphat at their head, returning to Jerusalem with joy, for the LORD had made them rejoice over their enemies.

28 They came to Jerusalem with harps and lyres and trumpets, to the house of the LORD.

Luke 17:17-18 NASB

17 Then Jesus answered and said, "Were there not ten cleansed? But the nine--where are they? 18 "Was no one found who returned to give glory to God, except this foreigner?"

GOD WILL CAUSE YOUR ENEMIES TO FEAR HIM

2 Chronicles 20:29-30 ESV

29 And the fear of God came on all the kingdoms of the countries when they heard that the LORD had fought against the enemies of Israel.

30 So the realm of Jehoshaphat was quiet, for his God gave him rest all around.
