Psalm 27:1-14 ESV Of David

1 The LORD is <u>my light</u> and <u>my salvation</u>; <u>whom shall I fear</u>? The LORD is <u>the stronghold of my life</u>; of <u>whom shall</u> I be afraid?

2 When evildoers assail me to eat up my flesh, my adversaries and foes, it is they who stumble and fall.

Isaiah 54:16-17 ESV

16 Behold, <u>I have created the smith</u> who <u>blows the fire of coals</u> and <u>produces a weapon for its purpose</u>. I <u>have also created the ravager to destroy</u>;

17 <u>no weapon that is fashioned against you shall succeed</u>, and <u>you shall refute every tongue that rises against you</u> in judgment. This is <u>the heritage of the servants of the LORD</u> and <u>their vindication from me</u>, declares the LORD."

Psalm 27:1-14 ESV Of David

3 <u>Though an army encamp against me</u>, my heart <u>shall not fear</u>; <u>though war arise against me</u>, yet <u>I will be</u> confident.

Romans 8:31-33 ESV

31 What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?

32He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how <u>will he not also with him</u> <u>graciously give</u> us all things?

33 Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies.

Psalm 27:1-14 ESV Of David

4 <u>One thing have I asked of the LORD</u>, that <u>will I seek after</u>: that I <u>may dwell in the house of the LORD</u> <u>all the days of my life</u>, to <u>gaze upon the beauty of the LORD</u> and to <u>inquire in his temple</u>.

5 For <u>He will hide me in His shelter</u> in the day of trouble; He will <u>conceal me under the cover of His tent</u>; <u>He will lift me high upon a rock</u>.

- Where do I find "His shelter" and how do I get there? By practicing verse 4.
- Verse 4 will make verse 5 a living reality.

Psalm 91:1-2 ESV

1 He who <u>dwells in the shelter of the Most High</u> <u>will abide in the shadow</u> of <u>the Almighty</u>. 2 I will say to the LORD, "<u>My refuge</u> and <u>my fortress</u>, my God, <u>in whom I trust</u>."

Psalm 91:7 ESV

7 A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you.

Psalm 91:9-10 FSV

9 <u>Because you have made the LORD</u> your <u>dwelling place</u>-- the Most High, who is my refuge-- 10 <u>no evil shall be allowed to befall you</u>, <u>no plague come near your tent</u>.

The Posture and Discipline of the Heart

Psalm 123:1 ESV A Song of Ascents.

- 1 To you I lift up my eyes, O you who are enthroned in the heavens!
- 2 Behold, <u>as the eyes of servants</u> <u>look to the hand of their master</u>, <u>as the eyes of a maidservant</u> to <u>the hand of her mistress</u>, so <u>our eyes look to the LORD our God</u>, <u>till He has mercy upon us</u>.

James 4:8 ESV

8 Draw near to God, and He will draw near to you.

<u>draw</u> <u>near</u> (engiz \bar{o} - to join one thing to another, to make near, approach, be at hand)

Hebrews 12:1-2 ESV

- 1 Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and <u>let us run with endurance</u> the <u>race that is set before us</u>,
- 2 <u>looking to Jesus</u>, <u>the founder</u> and <u>perfecter of our faith</u>, who <u>for the joy that was set before him</u> <u>endured the cross</u>, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.
 - We say to God, "The cross is too much, take it away." Wrong prayer to the Perfecter of our faith!
 - God says to us, "I will perfect your faith, so you can overcome the cross."
 - Our faith will never be perfected to overcome the cross if our eyes are not fixed on Him."

God Defends His People

Exodus 14:19-20 ESV

- 19 Then <u>the angel of God</u> who <u>was going before the host of Israel moved</u> and <u>went behind them</u>, and <u>the pillar of cloud moved</u> from <u>before them</u> and <u>stood behind them</u>,
- 20 <u>coming between the host of Egypt</u> and <u>the host of Israel</u>. And there was the cloud and the darkness. And <u>it lit up the night without one coming near the other</u> all night.

Romans 8:31 ESV

31 What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?

God Leads His People

Exodus 13:21-22 ESV

- 21 And the LORD went before them by day in a pillar of cloud to lead them along the way, and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, that they might travel by day and by night.
- 22 The pillar of cloud by day and the pillar of fire by night did not depart from before the people.

Numbers 9:15-23 ESV

- 15 On the day that the tabernacle was set up, the cloud covered the tabernacle, the tent of the testimony. And at evening it was over the tabernacle like the appearance of fire until morning.
- 16 So it was always: the cloud covered it by day and the appearance of fire by night.

- 17 And whenever the cloud lifted from over the tent, after that the people of Israel set out, and in the place where the cloud settled down, there the people of Israel camped.
- 18 At the command of the LORD the people of Israel set out, and at the command of the LORD they camped. As long as the cloud rested over the tabernacle, they remained in camp.
- 19 Even when the cloud continued over the tabernacle many days, the people of Israel kept the charge of the LORD and did not set out.
- 20 Sometimes the cloud was a few days over the tabernacle, and according to the command of the LORD they remained in camp; then according to the command of the LORD they set out.
- 21 And sometimes the cloud remained from evening until morning. And when the cloud lifted in the morning, they set out, or if it continued for a day and a night, when the cloud lifted they set out.
- 22 <u>Whether it was two days</u>, or <u>a month</u>, or <u>a longer time</u>, that <u>the cloud continued over the tabernacle</u>, <u>abiding there</u>, the people of Israel <u>remained in camp</u> and <u>did not set out</u>, but <u>when it lifted</u> <u>they set out</u>.
- 23 <u>At the command of the LORD</u> they <u>camped</u>, and <u>at the command of the LORD</u> they <u>set out</u>. <u>They kept the charge of the LORD</u>, at the command of the LORD by Moses.

Galatians 5:25 ESV

25 If we live by the Spirit, let us also keep in step with the Spirit.

God Satisfies His People

Psalm 145:13-20 ESV

- 13 Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and your dominion endures throughout all generations. [The LORD is faithful in all his words and kind in all his works.]
- 14 The LORD upholds all who are falling and raises up all who are bowed down.
- 15 The eyes of all look to you, and you give them their food in due season.
- 16 You open your hand; you satisfy the desire of every living thing.
- 17 The LORD is righteous in all his ways and kind in all his works.
- 18 The LORD is near to all who call on him, to all who call on him in truth.
- 19 He fulfills the desire of those who fear him; he also hears their cry and saves them.
- 20 The LORD preserves all who love him, but all the wicked he will destroy.
