Philippians 1:9 ESV

9 And it is my prayer that <u>your love may abound more and more</u>, with <u>knowledge</u> and <u>all discernment</u>, 10 so that you may <u>approve what is excellent</u>, and <u>so be pure</u> and <u>blameless</u> for <u>the day of Christ</u>, 11 <u>filled with the fruit of righteousness</u> that <u>comes through Jesus Christ</u>, to the glory and praise of God.

Proverbs 4:4-9 ESV

- 4 he taught me and said to me, "Let your heart hold fast my words; keep my commandments, and live.
- 5 Get wisdom; get insight; do not forget, and do not turn away from the words of my mouth.
- 6 Do not forsake her, and she will keep you; love her, and she will quard you.
- 7 The <u>beginning of wisdom</u> is this: <u>Get wisdom</u>, and <u>whatever you get</u>, <u>get insight</u>.
- 8 Prize her highly, and she will exalt you; she will honor you if you embrace her.
- 9 She will place on your head a graceful garland; she will bestow on you a beautiful crown."

Isaiah 30:20-22 ESV

20 And though the Lord give you the bread of adversity and the water of affliction, yet <u>your Teacher will</u> <u>not hide himself anymore</u>, but <u>your eyes shall see your Teacher</u>.

- 21 And <u>your ears shall hear a word behind you</u>, saying, "<u>This is the way</u>, walk in it," <u>when you turn to the right</u> or <u>when you turn to the left</u>.
- 22 <u>Then you will defile your carved idols</u> overlaid with silver and your gold-plated metal images. <u>You will</u> scatter them as unclean things. You will say to them, "Be gone!"

Acts 16:6-10 ESV

- 6 And they went through the region of Phrygia and Galatia, having been <u>forbidden by the Holy Spirit to</u> speak the word in Asia.
- 7 And when they had come up to Mysia, they attempted to go into Bithynia, but the Spirit of Jesus did not allow them.
- 8 So, passing by Mysia, they went down to Troas.
- 9 And <u>a vision appeared to Paul</u> in the night: <u>a man of Macedonia</u> was standing there, urging him and saying, "<u>Come over to Macedonia</u> and <u>help us</u>."
- 10 And when Paul had seen the vision, <u>immediately we sought to go on into Macedonia</u>, <u>concluding that</u> God had called us to preach the gospel to them.

Acts 10:9-22 ESV

- 9 The next day, as they were on their journey and approaching the city, Peter went up on the housetop about the sixth hour to pray.
- 10 And he became hungry and wanted something to eat, but while they were preparing it, he fell into a trance
- 11 and saw the heavens opened and something like a great sheet descending, being let down by its four corners upon the earth.
- 12 In it were all kinds of animals and reptiles and birds of the air.
- 13 And there came a voice to him: "Rise, Peter; kill and eat."
- 14 But Peter said, "By no means, Lord; for I have never eaten anything that is common or unclean."
- 15 And the voice came to him again a second time, "What God has made clean, do not call common."
- 16 This <u>happened three times</u>, and the thing was taken up at once to heaven.
- 17 Now while Peter was <u>inwardly perplexed</u> as to <u>what the vision</u> that he had seen <u>might mean</u>, behold, <u>the men who were sent by Cornelius</u>, having made inquiry for Simon's house, <u>stood at the gate</u>
 18 and <u>called out to ask</u> whether Simon who was called Peter was lodging there.
- 19 And while Peter was pondering the vision, the Spirit said to him, "Behold, three men are looking for you.
- 20 <u>Rise</u> and <u>go down</u> and <u>accompany them without hesitation</u>, for I have sent them."
- 21 And Peter went down to the men and said, "I am the one you are looking for. What is the reason for your coming?"
- 22 And they said, "Cornelius, a centurion, an upright and God-fearing man, who is well spoken of by the whole Jewish nation, was <u>directed by a holy angel</u> to <u>send for you</u> to <u>come to his house</u> and to <u>hear what you have to say</u>."

Acts 10:28-35 ESV

28 And he said to them, "You yourselves <u>know how unlawful it is for a Jew to associate with or to visit anyone of another nation</u>, but <u>God has shown me</u> that <u>I should not call any person common</u> or <u>unclean</u>. 29 So <u>when I was sent for</u>, <u>I came without objection</u>. I ask then why you sent for me."

- 30 And Cornelius said, "Four days ago, about this hour, I was praying in my house at the ninth hour, and behold, a man stood before me in bright clothing
- 31 and said, 'Cornelius, your prayer has been heard and your alms have been remembered before God.
- 32 Send therefore to Joppa and ask for Simon who is called Peter. He is lodging in the house of Simon, a tanner, by the sea.'
- 33 So <u>I sent for you at once</u>, and <u>you have been kind enough to come</u>. Now therefore <u>we are all here in the presence of God</u> to <u>hear all that you have been commanded</u> by the Lord."
- 34 So Peter opened his mouth and said: "Truly I understand that God shows no partiality,
- 35 but <u>in every nation anyone who fears him</u> and <u>does what is right</u> is <u>acceptable to him</u>.

Acts 10:44-48 ESV

- 44 While Peter was still saying these things, the Holy Spirit fell on all who heard the word.
- 45 And <u>the believers from among the circumcised</u> who had come with Peter <u>were amazed</u>, because <u>the gift of the Holy Spirit was poured out</u> even <u>on the Gentiles</u>.
- 46 For they were hearing them speaking in tongues and extolling God. Then Peter declared,
- 47 "<u>Can anyone withhold water for baptizing these people</u>, who have <u>received the Holy Spirit</u> just <u>as we have?</u>"
- 48 And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Then they asked him to remain for some days.

Acts 16:16-23 ESV

- 16 As we were going to the place of prayer, we were <u>met by a slave girl</u> who had <u>a spirit of divination</u> and <u>brought her owners much gain by fortune-telling</u>.
- 17 <u>She followed Paul</u> and us, <u>crying out</u>, "<u>These men are servants of the Most High God</u>, who <u>proclaim to</u> <u>you the way of salvation</u>."
- 18 And this <u>she kept doing for many days</u>. Paul, <u>having become greatly annoyed</u>, turned and said to the spirit, "<u>I command you</u> in the name of Jesus Christ <u>to come out of her</u>." And <u>it came out that very hour</u>.
- 19 But when her owners saw that <u>their hope of gain was gone</u>, they <u>seized Paul and Silas</u> and <u>dragged</u> <u>them into the marketplace</u> before the rulers.
- 20 And when they had brought them to the magistrates, they said, "These men are Jews, and they are disturbing our city.
- 21 They advocate customs that are not lawful for us as Romans to accept or practice."
- 22 The crowd <u>joined in attacking them</u>, and the magistrates <u>tore the garments off them</u> and <u>gave orders</u> <u>to beat them with rods</u>.
- 23 And when they had <u>inflicted many blows upon them</u>, they <u>threw them into prison</u>, <u>ordering the jailer</u> <u>to keep them safely</u>.
