★ REMEMBER


- ✓ Not everyone online is who they say they are
- ✓ It's okay to ask questions
- ✓ It's **always** okay to ask for help

📢 TELL A GROWN-UP IF:

- 🤫 Someone asks you to keep a secret
- 💬 Someone wants to move to a private chat
- 📷 Someone asks for pictures
- 😬 Something online makes you feel scared, confused, or uncomfortable

⚠️ GETTING HELP

You can talk to a:

- 👩 Parent or caregiver
- 👨 Teacher or school counselor
- 🏠  Safe Place® adult

🔍 DID YOU KNOW?

People who want to trick kids often start by being very nice.

They might:

- 👉 Say kind things
- 👉 Ask about your favorite games
- 👉 Act like a friend

If someone asks you to keep a secret, that's a sign to tell a grown-up. Nice words don't always mean someone is safe.

🎓 SMART HABBITs

- 👍 Don't share your name, school, or address
- 👍 Only talk to people your grown-up says are ok
- 👍 Stop and tell a trusted adult if something feels wrong
