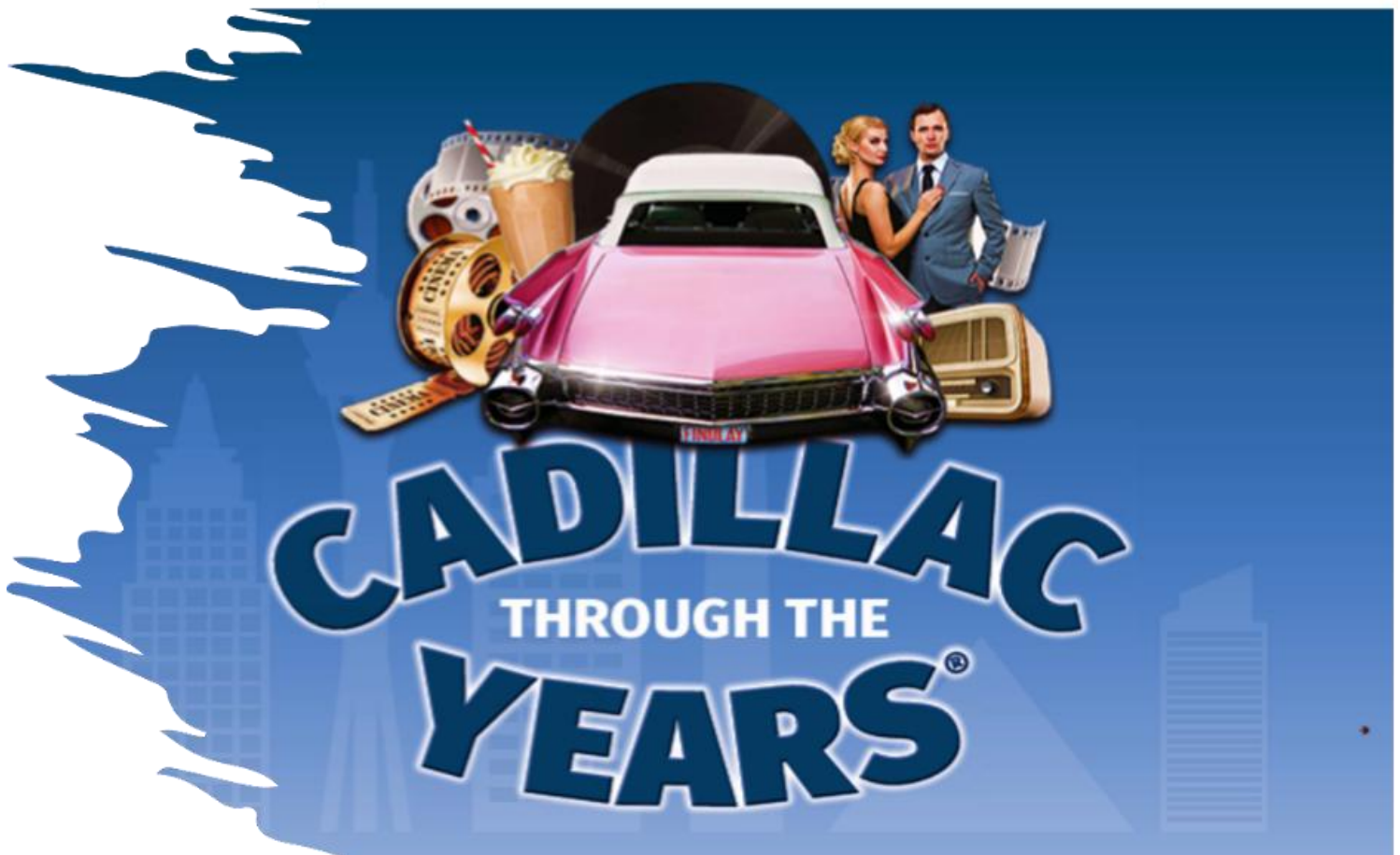

Cadillac F1 Update - Jon Nacy

Cadillac lovers - As of this writing, two F1 races for the 2026 season have been completed and the third round will be quickly upon us in Japan, scheduled for the weekend of March 27 – 29. The **season opener in Melbourne, Australia** resulted in our two Cadillacs presenting a pretty good showing for their debut race as a brand-new team and placing as follows:

- Sergio Perez finished in 16 th position 3 laps behind the leader.
- Valteri Bottas did not finish as his car retired on lap 16 with rumored issues of fuel delivery, transmission or steering wheel electrical/communications issues. During the race I noticed the cars running 3.5 to 4.7 seconds slower than the race leader. Looking at the fields lap times our team drivers need to be in the 2.3 – 2.5 second range to become competitive with the rest of the field in order to fight their way into points paying positions.

The **2nd round in Shanghai, China** was the opportunity to show what was learned and apply some data, fixes and enhancements.

- Sergio qualified in 22nd place (last) in the field (+3.73 sec) while
- Bottas placed 19th on the grid (+2.26 sec).
- The race ended with both cars finishing the race, which was a team goal. Bottas finished in 13th , while Perez placed in 15th.
- The real win here is that not only did both cars complete the race, but they were only 1 lap behind the leader and their race pace was within that +2.5 second pace I noted earlier.

Although the other teams logged improvements as well, it's promising that Cadillac is on the right track and making marked improvements. Only the top 10 positions are awarded points and after two races Cadillac is right there in the fight to earn them. The Suzuka circuit will prove additionally competitive and we wish our team the best for the coming weekend.

Special note: All races scheduled for April have been canceled due to the mid-east war and this will allow for more testing and evaluation on the cars for future changes and modifications.

F1 Livery? What's That?

An F1 livery refers to the car's entire paint scheme, graphics, and sponsor logos, a term borrowed from historic uniforms or insignia for servants/followers, meaning "dispensed" or "handed over" in French, indicating ownership or allegiance, now applied to the distinct visual branding of racing teams, especially when changing designs (like a special "coming back" livery).

Origin of the Term "Livery"

Historical Roots: The word comes from the French *livrée* (dispensed/handed over) and originally described the uniform provided to servants or followers to show allegiance to their master, as seen in "livery stables" for horse-drawn transport.

Aircraft Connection: The term was adopted for airplanes to describe their specific paint job and airline branding, identifying which company they belonged to.

F1 Livery Explained

More Than Paint: It's the complete visual design – colors, sponsor decals, and team fonts – that makes a car identifiable and iconic.

Sponsorship-Driven: Sponsorships became prominent in the late 1960s, replacing traditional national colors (like British Racing Green) with sponsor-led designs, making liveries crucial for branding.

Design Process: Liveries are complex, involving art, technical specs, and commercial needs, often designed months in advance and applied using a mix of paint and lightweight vinyl wraps.

"Coming Back" Livery

When a team or driver returns (e.g., after a break, or for a special event), they might unveil a new or nostalgic livery. This special design uses the same "livery" term because it's a new paint scheme/branding for the returning entity, showcasing their renewed presence and partners, like a fresh uniform for a returning follower.

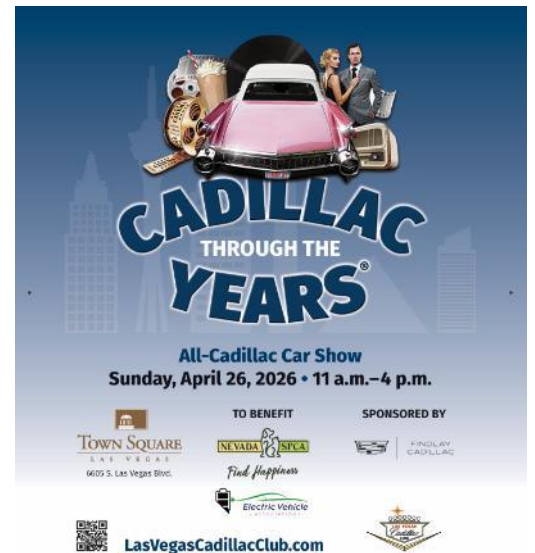

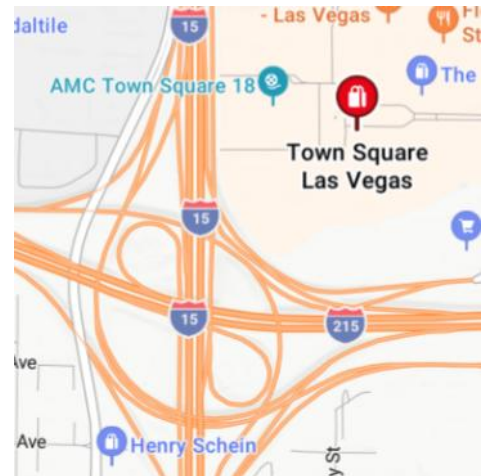

The college started with 60 students and a faculty of five. From its meager beginnings, it has now grown to a sprawling 27-acre campus with over 800 students on the west side of McPherson, Kansas.

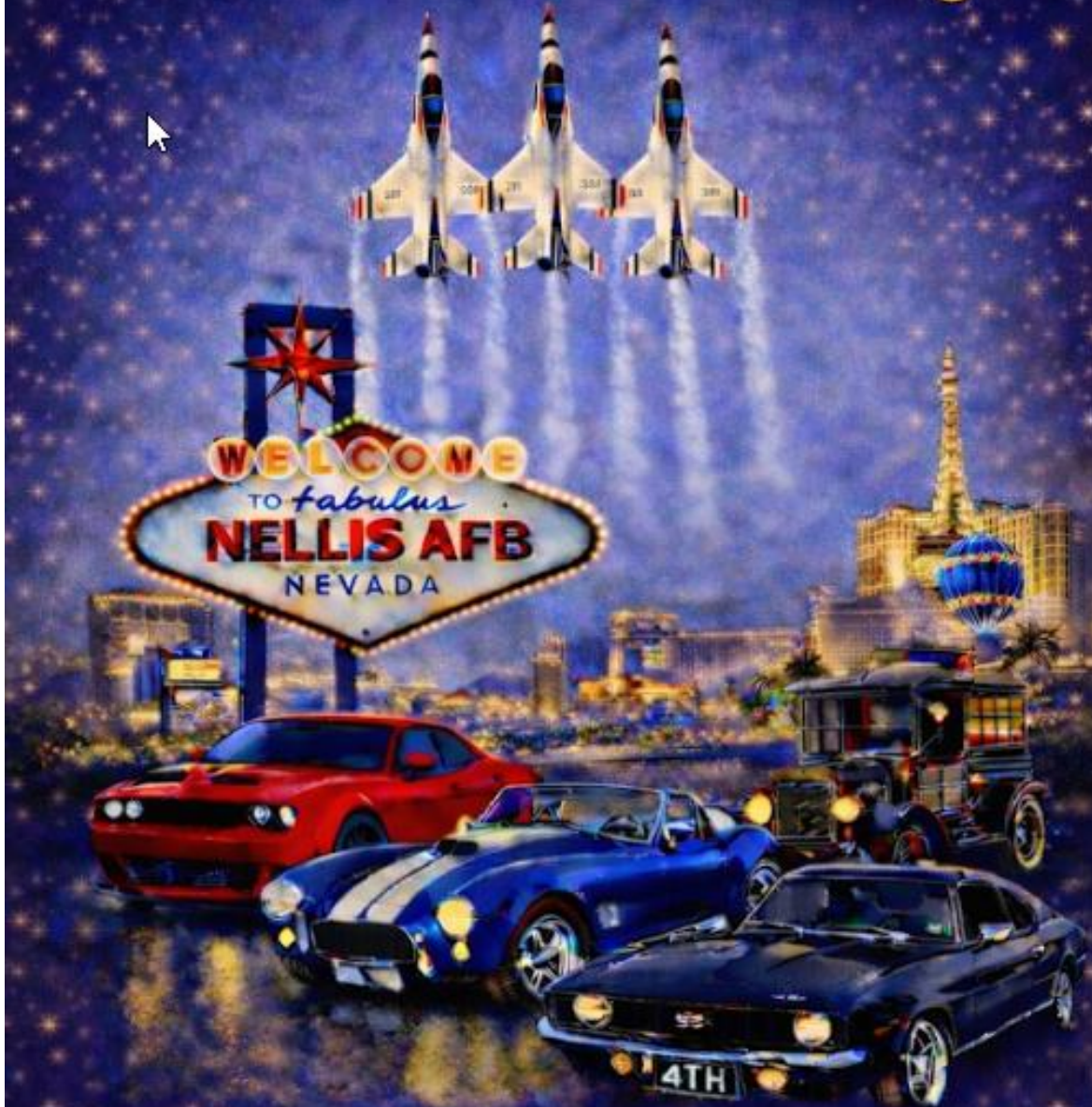

Cadillac LaSalle Club Museum & Research Center in Hickory Corners, Michigan



The Cadillac LaSalle Club Museum is located on the Gilmore Car Museum campus in southwest Michigan. Designed as a replica of a vintage Cadillac dealership, it houses the pre-eminent collection of Cadillac vehicles and memorabilia from 1903 to 2011 and is open year-round. Operated by the Cadillac LaSalle Club Museum & Research Center (CLCMRC), the cars on display show why "Cadillac" became synonymous with excellence in its first 50 years.



The CLCMRC also operates a Research Center in southeast Michigan that houses thousands of documents from Cadillac's beginning to the present day, providing an invaluable resource to researchers, historians, car enthusiasts and the public. This information can be accessed by phone and the CLCMRC website.

The Museum and Research Center were built and are operated using donations from thousands of generous CLC members over the last 25 years.

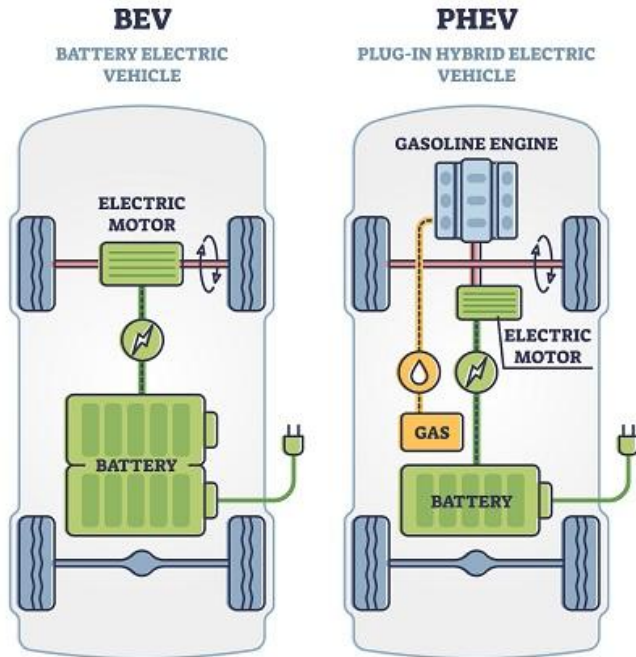

Vehicle Types

Electric mobility includes light-duty automobiles, medium- and heavy-duty electric vehicles, electric micromobility devices, and transit vehicles. The EV market is evolving rapidly, with models available in a range of vehicle types, from compact cars and sedans to sport utility vehicles (SUVs) and pickup trucks. Some EVs operate solely on batteries, while others are plug-in hybrid models with both an electric motor and an internal combustion engine. This section provides an overview of the various types of EVs and types of charging infrastructure, with information pertaining to light-, medium-, and heavy-duty electric vehicles, including battery electric buses (BEBs) used in transit applications, electric school buses (ESBs), and electric micromobility such as electric bicycles (e-bikes).

There are three types of electric vehicles available on the market:

- Battery Electric Vehicles (BEVs)
- Plug-In Hybrid Electric Vehicles (PHEVs)
- Fuel Cell Electric Vehicles (FCEVs) – Hydrogen

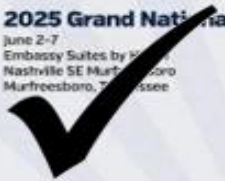
