## Climate Control

Opening and closing the window—if the car had them—was about as close to "climate control" as early cars offered. Aftermarket add-ons that captured heat from the exhaust system (a dangerous source), heated a separate water supply, or used electricity to emit tepid warmth all arose in the 1910s and 1920s. The modern heater core, a secondary radiator into which engine coolant circulates to warm the interior of the car, started showing up as an accessory add-on in the late 1920s and Cadillacs had it in 1926. It wasn't until 1938 that Nash was first to manage ventilation drawing air through the heater core from outside the car, though. The notion didn't really spread that rapidly. More than 30 years later, a heater was still optional on cheap cars. Dealer jargon for a basic car without options was one with "no stove (heater), no harp (radio)." First with air conditioning was the 1940 Packard. It was a two-year option, matched by Cadillac and Chrysler in 1941—then came WWII. Combining A/C, heat, and fresh air to hit a target temperature set by the car's occupants began with Nash in 1954, but it wasn't until 10 years later that the 1964 Cadillac successfully automated what we'd recognize as climate control like today's.

What is the first production car with heated seats?

While there are various assertions that a GM engineer patented the idea in the mid-1950s, the first production car with the option was the **1966 Cadillac DeVille**. Swedes like to take credit for making them standard, for the driver's seat only, on the 1972 Saab 99 and 96.





#### Why Is It Called WD-40?



## **Cadillac History: The “Last” American Convertible The 1976 Cadillac Eldorado**

The 1976 Cadillac Eldorado was heavily marketed by Cadillac as “The Last American Convertible”. Although that statement turned out not to be entirely true, this car marked the conclusion of an important era in American motoring. It signaled General Motors' overall shift away from the convertible body style and represented the end of the large, mid-century American convertibles with a characteristic bench seat configuration. Around 14,000 units of the '76 Eldorado Convertible were sold, with the last 200 marketed as the “Bicentennial Edition” commemorating America’s 200th birthday. These cars were finished in white with red and blue pinstripes and fitted with a commemorative plaque on the dashboard.

In the early 1980s, the demand for convertibles, previously thought to be on a permanent downward trajectory, went up again. As a result, Cadillac opted to reverse its earlier decision, meaning the 1976 Eldorado would no longer be the last American convertible. It wouldn't, as a matter of fact, even be the last convertible Eldorado. For the 1984 model year, the tenth-generation Eldorado once again offered a droptop option. The American Sunroof Corporation handled converting existing cars into officially produced convertibles, although other companies had carried out a few unofficial conversions in previous years. The return of the convertible body style was not met with a very warm reception by a particular group of customers: people who had purchased the '76 convertible on the basis of it being the “last” iteration. These drivers considered their cars to be rare, valuable investments, and felt the arrival of the 1984 convertible cheapened the value of their Cadillacs. As a result of this drop in value, two '76 convertible owners even attempted to file a lawsuit against GM on the grounds of false advertising, but they were unsuccessful.

The Eldorado convertible's revival, however, did not last very long. The body style was offered only for the last two model years of the Eldorado's tenth generation, in 1984 and 1985. The following year, the model's eleventh generation arrived, with the two-door coupe as the only available body style. A total of 5,500 Eldorado convertibles were built while it was briefly available.
