The framed size is limited to 16 inches on each side. Please follow standard requirements of art being framed or having finished canvas sides with the appropriate hanging wire. Each artist must provide his/her own table easel for displaying the work in case it is needed. Please **label your easel** with your name on the back.

Your artwork must have a **label** downloaded from the website taped to the back. You must also bring a signed Release and Agreement form from the website when you deliver your art on February 20.

Sales: Your artwork must be available for sale. We ask that you make a 20% donation to the Sanibel Historical Museum & Village if your work sells during the show. Any required shipping can be arranged between buyer and artist.
