Media: Paintings (including oil, acrylic, and watercolor), collage, pastel, mixed media, drawings, original prints (including etchings, wood block, linoleum, lithography, mono- prints), batik, sculpture, fiber arts, pottery, and fine basketry. No photography or giclee.

- ELECTRONICALLY REGISTER ONE OR TWO PIECES AND PAY. No photos of your work are required.



Friday, March 13, 2026

- 10:00 am to 12:00 pm Intake - ARTWORK and Document DROP OFF at the Civic Center
- 12:00 pm to 1:00 pm, enjoy lunch and fellowship as submissions are judged
- 1:00 pm to 1:30 pm, juror presentation, feedback, and announcement of winners (prizes will be awarded at the opening reception Thursday, March 19, 2026)
- 1:30 pm PICK UP of unselected submissions (artists to arrange with a colleague to pick up their artwork if they will not personally be present).

- Monica Rahman

Prerequisites:

- Artwork must be ready to hang and fitted with wire that reaches 3 inches below the top of the frame or canvas edge. Pieces larger than 30"x 40" may need thicker, sturdier wire. This determination will be made by CCA, but, it is the responsibility of the artist.
- Tape must be placed on the end of the wires for safety.
- All paintings must be thoroughly dry.
- Size limitations are unlimited but must weigh less than 50 lbs. and have adequate hanging materials.
- Plexiglass, instead of glass, should be used on any works over 16"x 20", except pastels.
- Sculpture, not mounted on a wall, must not exceed 48" in height (including pedestal), nor exceed 24" in width (including pedestal), nor weigh over 30 lbs. CCA has a limited number of pedestals available for 3D art.
- All works shall be newly rendered and not have been shown on Captiva before.
- All artwork must be "for sale".



- *Artists payment for entry fee **MUST** be submitted electronically. Signed CCA/SCAL Artist Agreement, Waiver documents, and labels must be brought to Receiving with artwork by artist or their designee.*
- All artwork shall remain for the duration of the exhibit, including sold pieces.

Publicity:

The Captiva Civic Association provides publicity in island papers and to its members via postcards and emails. The Sanibel-Captiva Art League publicizes this exhibition to its members, in island papers, and other entities as well as social media sites. [Note: Entrance into any show or Exhibit indicates agreement to comply and gives permission to take pictures of your artwork for use in above-mentioned advertising, publicity, and social media posts.]

More Show Logistics:

- Docents - EACH ARTIST SELECTED MUST VOLUNTEER AS A DOCENT FOR AT LEAST ONE WEEKDAY SESSION or arrange to have this obligation fulfilled by another. This will now be included on the artists agreement.
- CCA reserves the right to reschedule the viewing times if necessary.
- Private viewings with the CCA Executive Director will be offered to CCA members and interested buyers upon request. Contact via phone: (239) 472-2111

Sales:

- The CCA will collect the sales price for all pieces sold through the show. 60% of the total sale price will be recorded as due to the artist. CCA will take a 40% donation for sold pieces and will remit the balance minus any CC charges to the artist through the US Postal Service. Note the 40% of the total sale price will be recorded as a donation by the artist to the Captiva Civic Association.
- Once the sales transaction is processed, the artwork becomes the official property of the purchaser.
- All applicable sales taxes are the sole responsibility of the artist.
- Proceeds for works sold during the exhibition will be mailed to the artist, within 10 days of the final show date. Each artist must provide a preferred mailing address for each sold piece.
- **NOTE:** If an artist sells a piece within a 45-day period following the close of the exhibition, the artist is to remit a 40% donation to the CCA for all sold commissioned works resulting from the CCA Civic Hall exhibit.
