- 1. You must be a Sanibel Captiva Art League member.
- 2. You will be given an arrival date and pick up date, please adhere to the times. The SCAL Library committee will hang your artwork.
- 3. Have your artwork labels on the back with: Your name, medium, price, & contact number
- 4. Artists will deal directly with the buyers, there should be minimal interaction with the library staff.
- 5. A donation of 10% of your sale should be given to the library.
- 6. A donation of 10% of your sale should be given to SCAL.
- 7. Make sure there is your current Artist Bio in the Library Bio Book.
- 8. Largest Size is 20x24
- 9. No Sculptures
- 10. 5 artists show = 7-8 paintings each
- 11. 3 artists show = 10 -11 paintings each
- 12. Committee will be on hand to hang all shows
