

Passion Sunday Ritual

- Greeting: Father Kelly
- Prayer: "Dear brethren, since the beginning of Lent until now....
(Roman Missal - pg. 274)
- Sprinkling of the Palm Branches in the Narthex
- Gospel Reading Mark 11:1-10
- Reading of the Antiphons: (Father Kelly)

Antiphon 1 (RM pg. 280)

The children of the Hebrews, carrying olive branches, went to meet the Lord, crying out and saying:
Hosanna in the highest.

Antiphon 2 (RM pg. 281)

The children of the Hebrews spread their garments on the road, crying out and saying: Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.

Antiphon 10. R. (RM pg. 282)

As the Lord entered the holy city, the children of the Hebrews proclaimed the resurrection of life. Waving their branches of palm, they cried: Hosanna in the Highest.

- Prayer: Father Kelly (RM pg. 279- Note: this is in the Roman Missal **before** the antiphons read above.)
"Dear brethren, like the crowds who acclaimed Jesus in Jerusalem, let us go forth in peace."

- ✦ • Opening Hymn: "All Glory Laud and Honor" #498
(As Father processes into the Church, he will sprinkle any palms held by the people. Hymn continues until Father Kelly reaches the altar. **Mass proceeds as usual.**)
