II. Worship

Goal 1: To foster greater participation of parishioners during mass and other devotions.

- Objective 1: Offer an educational series explaining the sections of the Mass and devotions for better understanding
- Objective 2: Conduct ministry based retreats
- Objective 3: Conduct ministry fairs twice a year

Goal 2: To increase the numbers of members registered at Co-Cathedral of St. Theresa by 10%.

- Objective 1: Staff parish registry table after each mass
- Objective 2: Develop programs for returning Catholics
- Objective 3: Conduct annual RCIA class

Goal 3: To deepen the prayer life and spiritually of the parishioners.

- Objective 1: Conduct study/prayer sessions for better understand of the different types and forms of prayer (Inspired by St. Theresa)
- Objective 2: Conduct annual mission and retreat open to all parishioners and visitors

III. Formation in the Word of God

Goal 1: To form genuine Disciples of Jesus Christ through Evangelization of families.

Objective 1: Strengthen and support the Religious Education Program of the parish for children, youth/young adult and adult

Objective 2: Establish Youth and Young Adult Ministry

Objective 3: Increase attendance for bible study and Lectio Divina classes

Goal 2: To provide a support program for married couples in the parish.

Objective 1: Encourage and support the Couples for Christ ministry and Worldwide Marriage Encounter

IV. Social Ministry:

Objective 1: Provide annual domestic violence awareness to all leaders of ministries and interested parishioners.

Objective 2: Revive Stephen and Bereavement ministries to better meet the needs of the poor, sick and other parishioners requiring social and spiritual support in times of stress.

V. <u>Parish Leadership:</u>

Goal 1: To expand parish leadership that is reflective of our ethnic and age diverse community.

Objective 1: Establish a Stewardship committee to increase sharing of time, talent & treasure among parishioners

Objective 2: Conduct annual leadership training/retreat to recruit new committee members

Objective 3: Create a directory of parishioners/ministries/prayer groups/committees/councils/clubs and their missions and goals

Objective 4: Host annual appreciation day for all volunteers: ministries, committees and councils

Objective 1: Establish a Parish & School Planning and Building Committee (PPBC)

Goal 3: To increase parish revenue by 10% to support building and maintenance of facilities and paying down load by 2017.

Objective 2: Conduct at least 1 capital/fundraising campaign each year

Objective 3: Publish annual income and expenses and budget in the parish bulletin and website
