

HUCKLBERRY ACRES CAMPGROUND RULES

CAMPSITES: A "Unit" is defined as one (1) Tent, Pop-up Camper, Truck Camper, Travel Trailer, 5th Wheel, or Motorhome.

- **Single Campsites:** Limited to **one unit** per site.
- **Double Campsites:** Limited to a maximum of **two units** per site.

The "Pup Tent" Exception one (1) additional small "**pup tent**" may be pitched alongside a registered unit.

- This tent is intended for use by children (under 18) only.

SITE OCCUPANCY:

- **Single Campsite:** Limited to **one (1) family unit**, defined as two (2) adults and their legal dependents.
- **Double Campsite:** Limited to **two (2) family units**.
- **Maximum Occupancy:** Six (6) persons per family unit (unless legal dependents exceed four).

CAMPER & GUEST CHECK-IN

- **Requirement:** All CAMPERS & GUESTS must check in at the Camp Store immediately upon arrival.
- **Wristbands:** CAMPERS will be given a wristband, for their overnight stay, with their reservation paperwork. GUESTS will purchase a Day Use Wristband or Seasonal Wristband before entering the campground.
- **Vehicle Passes:** CAMPERS & GUESTS will be given a Vehicle Pass with their wristbands. Vehicle Passes **MUST BE** displayed in the front windshield on the driver's side of the vehicle.
- **Penalty:** GUESTS found without a wristband will be charged **double the standard rate**.

MAXIMUM SITE CAPACITY (CAMPERS + GUESTS) Total site occupancy is calculated by combining the number of overnight CAMPERS and their daytime GUESTS. The limits are as follows:

- **Single Campsites:** Maximum of **10 people** total.
 - *(Example: If you have 4 registered campers, you may host up to 6 visitors.)*
- **Double Campsites:** Maximum of **20 people** total.
 - *(Example: If you have 8 registered campers, you may host up to 12 visitors.)*

LODGING OCCUPANCY: limited to the **maximum number of people the unit is rated to sleep**.

- This limit applies to both adults and children.
- Exceeding the rated capacity of a lodging unit is a violation of site policy and fire safety regulations.

CHECK-IN / CHECK-OUT:

- **CAMPSITES: Check-in: 3:00pm / Check-out 11:00am**
 - Add this to your reservation for only \$15: Early Check-In at 1:00pm / Late Check-out at 1:00pm
- **LODGING: Check-in: 4:00pm / Check-out 11:00am**
 - Add this to your reservation for only \$45: Early Check-In at 1:00pm / Late Check-out at 1:00pm

QUIET TIME: 10:00 PM – 8:00 AM Daily

- **GUESTS** must depart the park by **10:00 PM**.
- **MINORS:** must be under adult supervision and back at their registered campsite by **10:00 PM**.
- **GOLF CARTS:** are not permitted to be operated between **12:15 AM and 7:00 AM**.
- **SAFETY:** For your protection, please carry a flashlight when walking through the park after dark

REFUNDS & CANCELLATIONS

- **Weather/Early Departure:** No refunds for weather conditions or early departures.
- **Holiday Weekends:**
 - **31+ days notice:** Refund minus a \$35 fee.
 - **0–30 days notice:** No refund.
- **Standard Weekends:**
 - **16+ days notice:** Refund minus a \$35 fee.
 - **0–15 days notice:** No refund.
- **No-Shows:** Failure to call and cancel results in total forfeiture of payment.
- **COVID-19:** If you test positive, contact us to reschedule. **No refunds or cancellations.**

GENERAL PET RULES

- **Aggressive Behavior:** Dogs showing protective or unfriendly behavior are not allowed. Aggression will result in immediate ejection without a refund.
- **Leashes:** Dogs must be leashed at all times (except in the Dog Park).
- **Supervision:** Never leave dogs unattended or tied up outside.
- **Waste:** Clean up after your pet immediately, everywhere on the property.

CAMPSITES

- **Fees:** First 2 dogs are free. Each additional dog is \$25 and requires approval.
- **Restrictions:** Portable fences or pens are prohibited.

LODGING UNITS

- **Fees:** \$45 per dog (Max 2 dogs; 50lb limit per dog).
- **Furniture:** Dogs are strictly prohibited on furniture; use a kennel or dog bed.
- **Unattended:** Dogs must be kenneled and quiet if left alone in the unit.
- **Penalty:** **Unregistered pets will result in immediate removal and a \$500 fine.**

LAKE & PONDS

- **Swimming (Huck's Lake ONLY):** Allowed at the sand beach only. Open Memorial Day – Labor Day, 10 AM to Dusk. **No swimming in Maggie's Pond or Wyatt's Trout Pond.**
- **Safety: No lifeguard on duty.** Swim at your own risk. No jumping off docks. Children 17 and under must be supervised by an adult at all times.

- **Life Jackets:** Highly recommended for swimming. **Required** FOR ALL AGES on inflatables, kayaks, paddle boards, paddle boats and canoes.
- **Access:** Activity Wristbands are required for entire CAMPGROUND including Huck’s Lake. Maggie’s Pond & Wyatt’s Trout Pond is restricted to CAMPERS with sites on those pond.
- **Beach Items:** Inflatable water & sand toys, lawn chairs, umbrellas, and towels are welcome.
- **Prohibited: No coolers or carry-in of food & beverages allowed.**
- **Conduct:** Unsafe or destructive behavior will result in removal for the duration of your stay.

ATTIRE & FOOD

- **Swimwear:** Modest, full-coverage swimwear is required.
- **Off-Beach Attire:** Shirts, shorts, and shoes are required in all buildings and on the patio.
- **Food:** No food on the sand beach. You may eat on the grass or the patio.

FIREWOOD & FIRE RINGS

- **Overnight CAMPERS:** One stack of firewood is included with your stay. Additional firewood is available for purchase at Maggie’s Market. \$8 per bundle / 5 bundles for \$35
- **Prohibited:** No carry-in of firewood for overnight CAMPERS. **Regulations: No outside wood permitted** from outside Waupaca County (per DNR/State law).
- **Fire Rings:** Only wood, cardboard, and paper may be burned. Do not move fire rings without CAMPGROUND approval. Cans/Garbage found in fire rings are subject to \$35 fine.
- **Seasonal CAMPERS:** Ask CAMPGROUND Director about approved firewood options

ICE is available for purchase at the Camp Store for your convenience. \$4 per bag / 5 bags for \$16

ATM is located inside both Huck’s Grill & Maggie’s Market for your convenience.

TRASH & DUMPSTERS

- **Disposal:** All trash must be placed inside designated dumpsters. Do not leave trash on the ground.
- **Household Only:** Dumpsters are for household garbage only. Electronics, batteries, furniture, construction materials, and appliances are **strictly prohibited**.
- **Charcoal:** Dispose of used charcoal in your site’s fire ring — **never** in the dumpsters.

SPEED LIMIT is 5 mph PLEASE OBEY for everyones safety. (Children and dogs are everywhere)

PARKING is limited to 2 Vehicles per site. Extra vehicles must be registered & parked in Overflow Parking.

ATV & UTV POLICY

- **Trail Access:** Riding is permitted only for travel between your campsite and the ATV trails.
- **No Joy Riding:** Recreational riding is strictly prohibited on CAMPGROUND premises.
- **Speed Limit:** Maximum speed is **5 mph** throughout the park.
- **Compliance:** Failure to follow these rules will result in the immediate loss of ATV/UTV privileges.

WASTE DISPOSAL

- **Dump Station:** On-site disposal is available and included with your CAMPSITE stay.
- **Honey Wagon Service:** For extended stays, a pump-out service is available for an additional fee. Schedule this at the Camp Store.
- **Prohibited Disposal: Wisconsin State Law prohibits** ground disposal of any gray or black water (including sink water). All wastewater must go into sewer tanks or dump stations.
- **Fine:** Violations identified by management or state inspectors will result in a **\$50 fine per occurrence.**

WATER HOOKUPS

- **Backflow Preventers:** CAMPGROUND has installed check valves on all spigots to prevent water contamination. **It is illegal to remove these valves.**
- **Replacement Fee:** If a backflow preventer is removed or missing from your site, your account will be charged **\$50.**
- **Water Connectors:** per Waupaca County Health Department regulations.
 - **Prohibited:** Water "Y" valves are illegal
 - **Allowed:** Water "T" connectors are permitted.
- **Fines:** Waupaca County Health Department and/or CAMPGROUND conducts periodic inspections. Any site found with a "Y" valve will be subject to County-imposed fines.

GOLF CARTS

- **Rentals:** Carts are available at the Camp Store. To reserve in advance, contact Reservations at **(920) 395-1500, ext. 2.**
- **Personal Carts:** Personal golf carts are **not permitted** on the property unless registered to a seasonal campsite.
- **Availability:** For pricing and daily availability, please inquire at the Camp Store during check-in.

FOOD & BEVERAGE CARRY-IN POLICY

- **State Law Compliance:** Per Wisconsin State Law, patrons are prohibited from bringing outside alcoholic beverages into licensed retail areas.
- **Prohibited Areas:** Food & Beverage Carry-ins are strictly prohibited in the following common areas:
 - **Maggie's Market**
 - **Huck's Grill, Patio & Squirly's Tiki Shack & Entertainment Stage**
 - **Wyatt's Play Park** (entire fenced area)
- **Purchase Requirement:** All Food & Beverages consumed in these designated areas must be purchased on-site.
- **Personal Sites:** You are welcome to enjoy your own food and beverages at your personal CAMPSITE or LODGING UNIT.

PROHIBITED ITEMS & CONDUCT

- **Restricted Items:** Fireworks, drones, atv/utv, golf cart and vehicle repairs are strictly prohibited.
- **Signage & Flags:** Only the American flag and sports team flags/signs are permitted. Political or social justice signs and flags are not allowed.
- **Tree Care:** Do not nail or screw any items into trees or shrubs. \$100 fine per tree may be assessed
- **Entertainment:** DJs, karaoke, or any live music are NOT PERMITTED on CAMPSITES. All entertainment is restricted to Squirly's Entertainment Stage and must be hired by the CAMPGROUND.
- **Conduct:** Excessive profanity, public drunkenness, nudity, lewdness, or aggressive behavior will not be tolerated.
- **Smoking & Vaping:** Prohibited inside all buildings (Lodging, Restrooms, Arcade, Store, Grill). This includes building entrances.
 - **Fine:** A **\$300 fine** will be assessed for smoking or vaping inside any building.

CONDUCTING BUSINESS

- **Policy:** CAMPERS are not permitted to conduct business or sell products/services of any kind within the campground.
- **Exceptions:** If you have a business you would like to offer the park, you must contact the owners for consideration.

REFUSAL OF SERVICE & CONDUCT

- **CAMPGROUND Rights:** We reserve the right to refuse service, limit the length of stay, or restrict the number of persons and vehicles per site.
- **Contract Termination:** CAMPGROUND reserves the right to terminate overnight stays, extended-stays or Seasonal Lodging Agreements and reject renewals at any time, for any reason.
- **Behavior:** We maintain a family-friendly environment. Gossiping, bullying, or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
- **Concerns:** If you are unhappy with your experience, please contact CAMPGROUND directly to discuss your options. (920) 395-1500, ext 2

INCLEMENT WEATHER If severe weather enters the area, we may be forced to temporarily close all attractions until the threat has passed which could be as short as 15 minutes or an entire day.

PRIVATE PROPERTY & CONDUCT

- **Respect:** This campground is private property. Please be respectful of our facilities, policies, staff, and your fellow CAMPERS.
- **Responsibility:** CAMPERS are responsible for the proper care of their CAMPSITE and the supervision of their children and pets.
- **Cleanup:** Ensure all trash is disposed of correctly before your departure.
- **Thank you for helping us keep the CAMPGROUND a great place to stay!**

PHOTOS & VIDEOS

- **Consent:** Entry to the CAMPGROUND constitutes permission for Hucklberry Acres Campground and its affiliates to photograph or video-record all CAMPERS and GUESTS.
- **Usage:** We reserve the right to use these images/videos for advertising, publication, or any other lawful purpose without credit or compensation.
- **Waiver:** By booking your stay, you grant irrevocable rights to these materials in all media forms and waive the right to inspect or approve the finished product.

LIABILITY & DAMAGES

- **Inherent Risk:** Camping is an outdoor recreational activity. By entering the CAMPGROUND, CAMPERS acknowledge and accept the inherent risks of the environment and recreational activities per **Wisconsin Law (Section 895.525, Wis. Stats.)**.
- **Limitation of Liability:** The CAMPGROUND (Camp Huck LLC, DBA: Hucklberry Acres Campground), its officers, employees, volunteers and its affiliates are not responsible for:
 - Accidents or injuries to CAMPERS or GUESTS.
 - Loss, theft, or damage to personal property or valuables.
 - Acts of nature, weather conditions, or the conduct of other CAMPERS.
- **GUEST Responsibility:** CAMPERS are solely responsible for the supervision of their children and GUESTS.
- **Property Damage:** CAMPERS agree to pay for any damage caused to CAMPGROUND property, buildings, equipment or amenities.
- **Enforcement:** CAMPGROUND reserves the right to interpret all RULES and eject any person or animal—without refund—for behavior detrimental to the safety and welfare of the park.
- **Agreement:** By signing your Overnight Registration and/or Seasonal Lodging Agreement, you acknowledge that you have read and understood these terms.
