### **OUR PROGRAM**

Our kindergarten program consists of a balance of exploration, investigation, guided, and direct instruction. Your child will have every opportunity to build on their existing knowledge, create and clarify their new understandings, and experience a variety of approaches to a problem or question.

In kindergarten we take advantage of the natural learning resulting from play and provide daily opportunities for learning in the classroom and outdoors. Children initiate free play and engage in structured play-based learning opportunities with questioning from teaching staff to provoke deeper thought and exploration. Our goal is to provide learning activities which encourage children to think creatively, to explore and investigate God's world, to solve problems, to engage in the inquiry process, and to share their learning with others. In the midst of all this "play", the children will master the foundations of language and math, be awed at the majesty of God's world around them, listen to the stories of the Old and New Testament, learn more about themselves and the beginnings of what it means to live as part of a Christian community, and so much more!

In the hallway outside the kindergarten classrooms, you will see our "I Can" statements which encompass literacy, math, problem solving, Christ-centred choices, and self regulation. The primary years provide our children the opportunity for so much exploration, growth, and development.

## A DAY IN THE LIFE











Our day in kindergarten begins with devotions, a Bible lesson, and a morning meeting. We explore a variety of materials and learning activities by following students interests through play. Our day contains learning blocks that focus on early literacy and foundational math skills. We love going to the outdoor classroom every day to extend our learning outside and explore God's world. Students also have music, physical education, and library throughout the week. Reading Buddies and STEM Friends are programs where intermediate students help lead kindergarten through STEM and reading activities, and build relationships with each other. Our day ends in prayer then bus buddies come to help kindergarten students who ride the bus. It's a busy day full of play, wonder, worship, and joy!


