

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT STEPS TO ENROLMENT

I. Please complete the following forms:

- 1. International Student Enrolment Form. Please include the following:
 - a. A photocopy of the student's birth certificate, visa and passport.
 - b. If applying for enrolment for more than one child, individual enrolment documents must be submitted for each child.
 - c. Original plus officially translated copies of transcripts and/or report cards for the past two years.
 - d. A photocopy of the student's medical insurance.
 - e. This form must be signed by the parent(s) or guardian(s) of the child.
- Statement of Christian Faith and Nurture Form. The family must provide confirmation of their active Christian faith. They must also confirm that their child will be in a Christian home during their enrolment at LCES.
- 3. **Medical Information Form.** All international students must have a medical exam completed by a qualified physician who must fill in this form (or attach the physician's own form to this document). PLEASE NOTE- The doctor's form must be translated into English.
- 4. **Statements of Agreement Form.** Please carefully read this form and initial each statement. Then the parent(s)/guardian(s) are asked to sign at the bottom and place the date.

II. Other items to note:

- 5. Tuition fees and any additional fees must be paid in full <u>prior</u> to the student starting classes. The \$500 Administration Fee must be included with the Enrolment Form and is non-refundable. See the **Tuition Fees** document.
- 6. After receipt of all required information, the LCES Board will make a decision with regard to acceptance at the school. Upon acceptance to LCES, a letter of acceptance will be sent.
- 7. The family is responsible for applying for passports and visas, and must provide the school with copies of these documents.
- 8. LCES provides a day school program only. We do not have boarding facilities at the school. However, the school can provide names of families who are willing to be a Home Stay Family.
- 9. First preference will be given to students who wish to enroll on a yearly or half-yearly basis. Tuition and associated fees will be pro-rated accordingly.
- 10. International students will only be admitted to classes where there is space and staff to adequately provide for their language and learning needs.
- 11. Students will be assessed by the Resource teacher to determine their level of English proficiency. They will then be placed in a class as close as possible to their age level.
- 12. Students admitted to LCES will be subject to the regular discipline policy and must comply with the code of student conduct as any other student at the school.
- 13. It is the responsibility of the international student's family to obtain a passport and student visa before beginning their studies at LCES.

III. School's Commitment:

The School will assist international students to comfortably integrate within their new school community by:

- 14. Providing clarification and guidance through the admissions process.
- 15. Extending a Christian welcome from the school community that will facilitate answers to general questions about moving into the community.
- 16. Arranging early ESL (language) testing to enable the appropriate placement of the student in the school.
- 17. Providing regular reports on the progress of those students that have been defined as requiring additional help adjusting as a result of language challenges.
- 18. Providing the same quality education for the international student as all other students at the school.
