From the Rector's Desk

ALLELUIA! CHRIST IS RISEN!

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

It felt so good to say that phrase three times on Easter Day! It was a day that we all had been anticipating since Ash Wednesday. In order to get to Easter Day, we had to do "our work." The Lenten season gave us ample amount of time to do some inner reflection, inwardly digesting what the Holy Spirit is trying to perfect within us, and to search our hearts for ways in which we can be more like Christ.

Easter Day was among other things: glorious, exciting, uplifting, and refreshing. We had 127 persons present to help celebrate the resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. It was most exciting and promising to see the number of youth in the Church and participating in the service. They are the future of St. Luke's. In order for them to be the future, they must be present to learn the service and various roles and duties so that when it is their turn, they will be able to step right in and keep the momentum alive.

I did something that I have asked most of you to do that contributed to the 127 people present as well as the number of lilies purchased. I invited people, made calls, and sent emails to family members and present and former parishioners. Many of you did the same because you introduced me to your guests. We must continue to invite, reclaim, and welcome those who are curious; those that want to return home, and those who visit. We are only given one time to make a good impression.

Sunday felt like a big family reunion in so many ways. It is my desire that we can keep that same feeling throughout the year, and not just on celebratory days. Jesus arose to show us that there is life after tragedy, life after death, and life in the world to come.

As we enter the Season of Easter and in the months to come, we have a lot of "in house" work to do. Our Senior Warden and Treasurer, Shauna Hicks, will host a forum on this coming Sunday to give you the latest State of the Parish Financial Address. It is important that we know where we are and where we need to be by the end of 2024.

There will be more programming coming our way in the months to come. One such example is that St. Luke's has been chosen to serve as the host Church for the Columbia Operatic Laboratory for the 2024 performance year. Basically, they will need a place to rehearse twice a month during the summer months and will perform their winter concert at the parish. This is just one of many new and refreshing things coming our way.

Thank you for your continued support with the Choral Fund and the contributions to the Blakely-Robinson Choral Fund, which also funds our extra choral singers and instrumentalists. If some of the young men in the Easter Brass Ensemble looked familiar, it is because two of them were with us on Shrove Tuesday. Their teacher worshipped with us on Sunday, much to the surprise of his students. We have an untapped resource in our colleges.

So, as I come to the close of this correspondence, I will leave you with these three words, Invite! Invite! Invite!


