Know Him

- **Bible Studies & Events** - Small study groups and presentations geared for adults
- **Faith Formation** - Catechesis and sacramental preparation for all ages and stages in life
- **LifeFORCE (Grades 6-8) & LifeTEEN (Grades 9-12)** - Geared towards teens growing in relationship with Jesus Christ and His Church through community and prayer
- **OCIA** - Geared for those inquiring, learning, and preparing for Christian Initiation
- **Vacation Bible School** - Summer program for kids of all ages
- **Young Adult Ministry** - Open to all spirited Catholic young adults from 18 to 39

Love Him

Christ's relationship with the Father was deeply rooted in prayer and from this relationship flowed His whole life and ministry.

- **Altar Servers** - Children in grade 5 and older as well as adults assist with Mass
- **Deaf/Hard of Hearing Ministry** - Provides access for all to share in prayer through ASL interpreted Mass
- **Emmaus** - Independent, spiritual retreats for men and women from lay people for lay people to renew faith through prayer, worship, and discussion
- **Eucharistic Adoration** - Adore and honor the Eucharistic Presence of Christ
- **Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion** - Assist priests in the distribution of the Eucharist
- **Lectors** - Proclaim the Lectionary Readings at Mass
- **Music Ministries** - Serve God and others in His name through music

Serve Him

Christ renounced power and glory for a life of service - through His healings, miracles, comforting words, and heartfelt compassion, He served people and their deepest needs.

- **Bereavement Support Group & Counseling Services** - Help to provide comfort and peace
- **Food Bank** - Sources and distributes food to 52 ministries and churches in the area in conjunction with *Feeding Tampa Bay*
- **Food Pantry** - Sorts and shares staples including meat, fruit, vegetables, and hygiene essentials to over 150 families every Thursday
- **Legion of Mary** - Serve the Church and their neighbors through prayer and volunteerism
- **Men's Club & Knights of Columbus** - Men who live their faith through charity, service, and prayer
- **Visitation to Homebound, Hospitals & Nursing Homes** - Spending time with and bringing the Eucharist to those unable to come to Church
- **Women's Guild** - Five groups of women who work in communion with each other to grow spiritually and serve their community
