



Based on each fund's intentions, we invest in our 12-county region through grants.





## 2024 Program Highlights & Updates

2<sup>nd</sup> Year of the Community Grants re-branded program

No disqualification for technical errors

Due date of May 1 to allow for grace period

Simplified application (financials, bids, fewer questions)

NEW – No \$2,500 cap on general support requests



## **Available Funds**

For the Community Grant Program:

- Unrestricted
- Field of Interest
- County Endowment



TIP: Review Field of Interest Fund purposes to see if any "fit" with any projects of your organization. While you can't apply for a specific fund, you can tailor your request & include key words.

### Organization Type

- The Community Foundation can make grants to:
  - > 501(c)(3) organizations
  - > Government entities for public and charitable purposes
  - > Religious organizations as defined in 170(b)(1)(A) of the IRS Code
- Non-eligible organizations may submit requests for charitable purposes under the umbrella of a 501(c)(3) organization who has agreed to be a Fiscal Sponsor.

Through the Community Grant program, the Community Foundation seeks to fund requests that will:

- ✓ Provide unique, innovative, or proven solutions to demonstrated community needs and opportunities
- ✓ Make a significant impact on the success of the overall project/program
- ✓ Assist the organization in **expanding** or **enhancing** the delivery of its mission, particularly for underserved or atrisk populations
- ✓ Leverage community collaborations to maximize the impact on the community and population served
- ✓ Reach a significant number of community members or specific groups of **underserved community members** throughout its 12-county service area.

## A Note on Recurring Requests

It is accepted to apply for the same program each year.

However, if you do, take time to demonstrate how funding will **expand** or **enhance** prior results. Or, demonstrate how the need has **grown** faster than funding. What other funding sources are being sought?

Be specific and include past metrics and current goals.







**Community Grants (formerly Competitive Grants)** 

The Community Foundation annually awards grants from Field of Interest and Unrestricted Endowment Funds through its *Community Grant* process to meet needs and advance opportunities in its 12-county region. Grants are made based on funds available including those that are restricted for specific geographic and/or interest areas. Through the *Community Grant* program, the Community Foundation seeks to honor the intent of the endowments that fund the program while strengthening nonprofit services to ultimately enhance the quality of life throughout the region that we serve.

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

Grants may be awarded to:

- Nonprofit organizations that are recognized as exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the IRS Code
- Government entities applying for grants that are exclusively for <u>public or charitable purposes</u>
- <u>Faith-based organizations applying for grants that benefit the public good</u>, but not for specifically religious or sectarian purposes, or programs that require participation in a religious activity as a condition for receiving services.
- Applicant organizations and grants awarded must serve at least one of the following 12 counties: Adams, Brown, Hancock, or Pike in Illinois; Clark, Knox, Lewis, Marion, Monroe, Pike, Ralls, or Shelby in Missouri.

#### **Grant Criteria:**

- Grants will be made for programs and projects in the areas of arts and culture, community betterment, education, health, and human services.
- Applications may be submitted for program/project support or general operating support; however, all applications will be evaluated using the same criteria.

## More Helpful Hints

- How does this request fit within your organization's unique mission?
- Right-size your request -- a \$7,500 request for a \$750,000 budget won't go very far.
- Convey <u>impact</u> who will this funding ultimately support and what will it achieve?
- Be **specific** anticipate what questions someone unfamiliar with your program might have.
- Be <u>realistic</u> what can you achieve within the bounds of your capacity and limitations of this and other funding?
- If it's a long-standing program, how will this funding enhance it? What's changed? Has need increased?
- Will, or can, these dollars be used to leveraged additional funding (e.g., a match)?
- Review Field of Interest fund descriptions do any describe your mission or project?



- Define acronyms and abbreviations. Don't assume reviewers know what they mean!
- If you're applying for operating support, how will this grant fill a gap, strengthen this work, or build your capacity? How will it help you achieve your mission? What other sources of operating support do you have?
- If you received a competitive grant in 2023, your grant report must be completed by June 1 in order to be eligible for a 2024 community grant.
- If you need clarification on any questions or document requirements, *call us*!
- Have the Community Foundation <u>review</u> your application before you submit. Deadline for request is **April 12**, 2024.
