ADOPT-A-HIGHWAY

Once again we are looking for volunteers to assist with highway pick up.

Scheduled date is Saturday September 20th ,
with make-up date Sept. 27.

We are hoping the Boy Scouts will be helping. We clean up trash on the shoulders of US 127 for the 2miles just north of the north Clare exit, along both the northbound and southbound lanes.

It takes about 4 hours (2 hours each side of the highway).

That is depending on how much help we get. We typically clean up along the northbound lanes first, then stop for a snack and drink at Snowsnake, before coming back to clean up alongside the southbound lanes. Safety vests, gloves and vehicle identification placards are provided. Wearing sturdy shoes/boots and light colored clothing are recommended. Ages 12 and up can help.
