### ***Ash Wednesday Schedule***

Lent Season begins on Ash Wednesday, **February 22, 2023**. Mass schedule for Ash Wednesday will be **8:30am, 6:00pm** and Liturgy of the Word and distribution of ashes at **12:30pm**.

Stations of the Cross will begin Friday, **February 24, 2023** at 6:30pm in the Church and will continue every Friday during Lent.

### ***Lenten Observances***

**Abstinence.** The law of abstinence requires a Catholic 14 years of age until death to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays in honor of the Passion of Jesus on Good Friday. Salt and freshwater species of fish are permitted.

**Fasting.** The law of fasting requires a Catholic from the 18th birthday to the 59th birthday to reduce the amount of food eaten from normal. The Church defines this as one meal a day and two smaller meals which, if added together, would not exceed the main meal.

**Those who are excused from fast or abstinence.** Besides those outside the age limits; those of unsound mind, the sick, the frail, pregnant or nursing women according to need for meat or nourishment, manual laborers according to need, and other situations of moral or physical impossibility to observe the penitential discipline.

### ***Quinceanera Retreat***

The Quinceanera Retreat dates for 2023 have been scheduled for March 4, June 3, August 12 and October 21. A Quinceanera retreat is a requirement for a Quinceanera Mass. Retreat Fee is \$100.
