

Divine Mercy Holy Hour will be held on January 1, 2023 at 3:00pm in the St. Jude Chapel.







### Mary, Holy Mother of God January 1, 2023



### On the Liturgy of the Hours: The Breviary

Christmas Greetings to all of you! As we embark into this new year, we will be adding a new devotional practice to our daily schedule here at Most Precious Blood, as we begin to pray Morning Prayer together before each daily morning Mass, beginning at 8:10am on Monday, 16 January, 2023. Father Joseph asked me to offer a brief explanation of this ancient practice, what the Breviary is, and why the Church has prayed in this way since the very beginning.

The Liturgy of the Hours, also known as the Breviary, is a series of prayers centered around the Old Testament Psalms, and prayed five times every day by all priests, nuns, monks, and religious brothers and sisters throughout the world. While lay people are not bound by vows to pray the Breviary daily, it is part of the official prayer of the Church, and thus encouraged for all the faithful. As the Breviary points out, praying in this way "fulfills the Lord's precept to pray without ceasing, at once offering... praise to God the Father and interceding for the salvation of the world." This practice of praying several times a day finds its roots in Ancient Judaism, where faithful Jews to this day stop what they are doing to pray throughout the day. Our Lord Himself and all the Apostles would have also carried out this religious practice, so the Church sees the Liturgy of the Hours as yet another way we can imitate Christ, in His prayer to the Father.

Finally, the tradition of the Church has given us the Breviary as a way of sanctifying each day and making it holy, as we take a moment to invite God into the picture, into whatever we might be doing at that moment, to praise Him for His goodness and to ask for His continued help. The Liturgy of the Hours is a beautiful way in which the members of the Church are able to be united in prayer throughout the world, so we invite you all to join us in the days and weeks to come, praying Morning Prayer together before each of our daily morning Masses.

### St. Albert the Great & St. Maria Faustina Kowalska

### St. Albert the Great (1206 - November 15, 1280) Feast Day Nov. 15

Albert the Great was a 13th-century German Dominican who decisively influenced the Church's stance toward Aristotelian philosophy brought to Europe by the spread of Islam. Students of philosophy know him as the master of Thomas Aquinas. Albert deserves recognition on his own merits as a curious, honest, and diligent scholar. He was educated in the liberal arts. His boundless interests prompted him to write a compendium of all knowledge: natural science, logic, rhetoric, mathematics, astronomy, ethics, economics, politics, and metaphysics. His explanation of learning took 20 years to complete. "Our intention," he said, "is to make all the aforesaid parts of knowledge intelligible to the Latins." He achieved his goal while serving as an educator at Paris and Cologne, as Dominican provincial, and even as bishop of Regensburg for a short time. He defended the mendicant orders and preached the Crusade in Germany and Bohemia. St. Albert, a Doctor of the Church, is the patron saint of scientists and philosophers.

### St. Maria Faustina Kowalska (August 25, 1905 – October 5, 1938) Feast Day Oct. 5

Saint Faustina's name is forever linked to the annual feast of the Divine Mercy, the Divine Mercy chaplet, and the Divine Mercy prayer recited each day at 3 p.m. by many people. Born in what is now west-central Poland, Helena Kowalska was the third of 10 children. She worked as a housekeeper in three cities before joining the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy in 1925. She worked as a cook, gardener and porter generously serving the needs of the sisters and the local people, Sister Faustina also had a deep interior life. This included receiving revelations from the Lord Jesus, messages that she recorded in her diary at the request of Christ and of her confessors. At a time when some Catholics had an image of God as such a strict judge that they might be tempted to despair about the possibility of being forgiven, Jesus chose to emphasize his mercy and forgiveness for sins acknowledged and confessed. "I do not want to punish aching mankind," he once told Saint Faustina, "but I desire to heal it, pressing it to my merciful heart." The two rays emanating from Christ's heart, she said, represent the blood and water poured out after Jesus' death. Because Sister Maria Faustina knew that the revelations she had already received did not constitute holiness itself, she wrote in her diary: "Neither graces, nor revelations, nor raptures, nor gifts granted to a soul make it perfect, but rather the intimate union of the soul with God. These gifts are merely ornaments of the soul, but constitute neither its essence nor its perfection. My sanctity and perfection consist in the close union of my will with the will of God." Sister Maria Faustina died of tuberculosis in Krakow, Poland, on October 5, 1938. Pope John Paul II beatified her in 1993, and canonized her seven years later.
