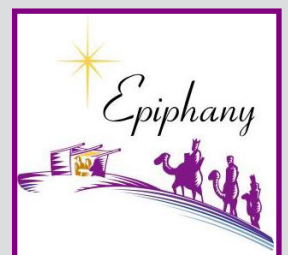

## Epiphany of the Lord January 8, 2023

The word "epiphany" comes from the Greek epiphainen, a verb that means "to shine upon," "to manifest," or "to make known." Thus, the feast of the Epiphany celebrates the many ways that Christ has made Himself known to the world, mainly the three events that manifested the mission and divinity of Christ: the visit of the Magi (Matthew 2:1-12), the baptism of Jesus (Mark 1:9-11), and the miracle at Cana (John 2:1-11).

On the Liturgy of the Hours: The Breviary

Christmas Greetings to all of you! As we embark into this new year, we will be adding a new devotional practice to our daily schedule here at Most Precious Blood, as we begin to pray Morning Prayer together before each daily morning Mass, beginning at 8:10am on Monday, 16 January, 2023. Father Joseph asked me to offer a brief explanation of this ancient practice, what the Breviary is, and why the Church has prayed in this way since the very beginning.

The Liturgy of the Hours, also known as the Breviary, is a series of prayers centered around the Old Testament Psalms, and prayed five times every day by all priests, nuns, monks, and religious brothers and sisters throughout the world. While lay people are not bound by vows to pray the Breviary daily, it is part of the official prayer of the Church, and thus encouraged for all the faithful. As the Breviary points out, praying in this way “fulfills the Lord’s precept to pray without ceasing, at once offering... praise to God the Father and interceding for the salvation of the world.” This practice of praying several times a day finds its roots in Ancient Judaism, where faithful Jews to this day stop what they are doing to pray throughout the day. Our Lord Himself and all the Apostles would have also carried out this religious practice, so the Church sees the Liturgy of the Hours as yet another way we can imitate Christ, in His prayer to the Father.

Finally, the tradition of the Church has given us the Breviary as a way of sanctifying each day and making it holy, as we take a moment to invite God into the picture, into whatever we might be doing at that moment, to praise Him for His goodness and to ask for His continued help. The Liturgy of the Hours is a beautiful way in which the members of the Church are able to be united in prayer throughout the world, so we invite you all to join us in the days and weeks to come, praying Morning Prayer together before each of our daily morning Masses.

## **St. Teresa of Avila & St. Thomas Aquinas**

**Saint Teresa of Avila (March 28, 1515 – October 4, 1582) Feast Day Oct. 15**

Teresa Sanchez Cepeda Davila y Ahumada was born in the Castilian city of Avila on March 28, 1515. As a child, Teresa felt captivated by the thought of eternity and the vision of God granted to the saints in heaven. When Teresa was 14, her mother died, causing a profound grief that prompted her to embrace a deeper devotion to the Virgin Mary as her spiritual mother. She joined the Carmelite Order but soon developed a serious illness that forced her to return home. She insisted on returning to the Carmelite monastery even though she remained in a painful and debilitated state. As her health returned, Teresa lapsed into a more routine prayer life. At nearly 40, Teresa found herself dramatically called back to the practice of contemplative mental prayer. She experienced profound changes within her own soul, and remarkable visions that seemed to come from God. Teresa had always been accustomed to contemplate Christ's presence within her after receiving him in the sacrament of Holy Communion. Teresa played a significant role in the renewal of the Church that followed the Council of Trent. She proposed a return of the Carmelites to their original rule of life, founded on silence and solitude. Together with the priest and writer later canonized as Saint John of the Cross, she founded what is known today as the Order of Discalced Carmelites – “discalced,” meaning barefoot, symbolizing the simplicity to which they chose. Teresa's health failed her for the last time while she was traveling through Salamanca in 1582. She was canonized on March 22, 1622, along with three of her greatest contemporaries: St. Ignatius Loyola, St. Francis Xavier, and St. Philip Neri. Her writings, especially the *Way of Perfection* and *The Interior Castle*, have helped generations of believers. In 1970, the Church gave her the title she had long held in the popular mind: *Doctor of the Church* along with 14th century Dominican St. Catherine of Siena. She is the patron saint of relief from headaches.

**St. Thomas Aquinas (1225 – March 7, 1274) Feast Day Jan. 28**

He is one of the great teachers of the medieval Catholic Church, honored with the titles Doctor of the Church and Angelic Doctor. At five he was given to the Benedictine monastery at Monte Cassino. In 1239, he was sent to Naples to complete his studies. It was here that he was first attracted to Aristotle's philosophy. By 1243, Thomas joined the Dominicans, he went to Paris and then to Cologne, where he finished his studies with Albert the Great. He held two professorships at Paris, lived at the court of Pope Urban IV, directed the Dominican schools at Rome and Viterbo. His greatest contribution to the Catholic Church is his writings. He was broad enough, deep enough, to see the whole natural order as coming from God the Creator, and to see reason as a divine gift to be highly cherished. The *Summa Theologiae*, his last and, unfortunately, uncompleted work, deals with the whole of Catholic theology. He stopped work on it after celebrating Mass on December 6, 1273. When asked why he stopped writing, he replied, “I cannot go on.... All that I have written seems to me like so much straw compared to what I have seen and what has been revealed to me.” He died March 7, 1274. He is patron saint of Catholic Colleges and Universities, Educators/Teachers, Philosophers/Theologians and students.
