

Privacy Policy

Effective September 9, 2026

Most Precious Blood Catholic Church respects your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, protect, and disclose personal information provided through our website, registration forms, ministries, programs, and text-messaging services.

Information We Collect

We may collect information that you voluntarily provide, including your name, mailing address, email address, mobile phone number, household or family information, parish registration information, ministry interests, program registrations, payment information, and communications with the parish. We may also collect limited technical information when you use our website, such as browser type, device information, and website activity, when supported by our website services.

How We Use Information

We may use personal information to administer parish programs and services; process registrations and payments; communicate about Masses, ministries, Faith Formation, events, schedules, cancellations, emergencies, and other parish matters; respond to questions; maintain parish records; improve our website and communications; and comply with legal, diocesan, financial, or safety obligations.

SMS and Mobile Information

If you provide your mobile phone number and expressly opt in, we may send parish-related SMS or text messages. Message frequency varies. Message and data rates may apply. You may opt out at any time by replying STOP. For assistance, reply HELP or contact the parish.

Mobile information, text-messaging originator opt-in data, and consent will not be shared, sold, rented, or disclosed to third parties or affiliates for their marketing or promotional purposes. We may share information with service providers only as needed to deliver parish communications and operate the messaging program, subject to appropriate confidentiality and data-protection obligations.

How We Share Information

We do not sell personal information. We may share information with parish staff, authorized volunteers, the Diocese, and trusted service providers when reasonably necessary to operate parish programs, maintain records, process payments, deliver communications, support the website, protect people or property, or comply with law. Service providers may use information only for the services they provide to the parish.

Data Security and Retention

We use reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards designed to protect personal information. No method of storage or transmission is completely secure. We retain information only as long as reasonably necessary for parish, sacramental, administrative, legal, financial, safety, or recordkeeping purposes.

Your Choices

You may request that the parish update inaccurate contact information. You may unsubscribe from email communications using the available unsubscribe option and may stop SMS messages by replying STOP. Opting out of promotional or informational messages does not prevent the parish from contacting you when otherwise permitted or necessary for an active registration, transaction, safety matter, or legal obligation.

Children's Information

Information about children may be collected from a parent or legal guardian in connection with Faith Formation, sacramental preparation, youth ministry, childcare, or other parish activities. The parish uses that information to administer the applicable program and protect participants.
