Usher Report: Maryrose has been in conversation with Ben Verhage; Dan Swiatkowski is willing to mentor. Mike added that ushers should be more proactive in getting people seated and being aware of potential emergencies.

Pastoral Council Report by Arleen Mantel: Fellowship Sunday will not happen on March 15th due to the auction. Three candidates have interviewed for Jill Sheehan's position. Connie Helm has resigned as Director of Development. The 8th grade boys won the Seaton volleyball tournament. The All-Commission meeting will be held January 11th between the 8 and 10:30 AM Masses in the cafeteria. Each commission has 5-7 minutes to speak. The Disaster Relief fund was very generous; four-five families will benefit. A committee will decide how to distribute the funds, and Maryrose suggested that there should be some communication to parishioners on the outcome. Safety of parishioners was a main topic at the recent Denary with Archbishop Grob. \$39,000 was raised by the flea market and \$13,000 was raised with the calendar raffle. A ministry guide is being developed, and a ministry fair will be held in September. Christian formation has three adults and one teenager. Lots of diapers and wipes were donated to Human Concerns. The Giving tree is in progress and will end on 12/14/25.
