<u>Driver Information Guide – Scunthorpe Sunday 28th September</u>

Please note the office will close at 4pm on Friday 26th September and queiries may not be seen after this time.

Stadium Arrival

It is important that you do not arrive before 10am, arrival before this time means staff cannot get onto site and it will cause is big problems.

Pit Parking

You will be directed where to park, please park up where instructed to ensure we can get everyone in and parked well.

Pit Office

This works the same as Skegness, drivers park up and then come to the pit office for their wristband and to sign in.

Drivers should come to the pit office with themselves and all of their free passes together. (e.g. an F1 driver should come with themselves and 3 mechanics all together).

Anyone outside of these passes must enter via the turnstiles with their pre booked tickets.

Tickets are not sold on the day at the pit office, these should be done online in advance.



Tickets

We do understand some people do not like the idea of having to purchase a ticket in advance however there is a smaller capacity at Scunthorpe compared to other tracks. This option means we will not have to turn away people if we reach capacity who have travelled to get in.

Tickets are available online only at www.YorStox.co.uk, there is no 'cut off' for when these are available for. If they are still available on the day then you can still purchase online subject to availability.

When you purchase a ticket you should receive a confirmation with a QR code on it that is what we will need on the day to admit you into the stadium. If you have purchased 2 tickets together they will be all on the same QR code.

There will be a member of the team available on the day dealing with ticket enquiries, so if you are struggling to locate your tickets we will be able to help you on the day so please do not worry.

Food and Drink

Food and Drink can be taken into Scunthorpe, however sorry no alcohol or glass.

Food and Drink can be purchased at the stadium from one of the catering outlets.

Dogs

Well behaved dogs can be taken into the stadium on leads, they must remain on a lead at all times and you please must pick up after them.

Pit Access

Upon arrival when your ticket is scanned you will be issued with a wristband. This permits you access to and from the stadium and into the pits throughout the event. Please ensure this is shown fully to the security staff, if you attempt to enter the pits without a wristband you will need to pay again.

Driver Briefing


This takes place for all formulas outside the pit office at 12:15pm. Attendance is mandatory so we can explain the procedures for on track.

Stadium access and egress

No mechanics should enter via the pit gate entrance that cars will go through to enter the track. All mechanics and team members enter the stadium in and out via the turnstile entrances only.

Any mechanics found entering or exiting through the car entrance will be loaded for the day.
