St. John the Baptist Cemetery is a privately owned Catholic cemetery. In addition to all the rules and regulations of the Diocese of Manchester, owner of St. John the Baptist Catholic Cemetery on River Road and the old St. John the Baptist Catholic Cemetery on Granite Street, both in Allenstown, St. John the Baptist Parish adds the following for the upcoming season:

FLOWERS, DECORATIONS, ETC.

1. In-ground plantings are strictly forbidden.
2. Real or artificial flowers and/or memorabilia are allowed year-round only on the monuments themselves or in containers on the monument bases; for memorabilia, please use appropriate reminders of your loved one.
3. In-Ground plantings are strictly forbidden.
4. Small American flags are allowed year-round as long as they are placed as close to the base as possible. All faded and/or torn flags should be removed.
5. Flowers are allowed on the ground ONLY during the Memorial Day holiday. The available dates are always published in the bulletin and on this website.
6. Other than the Memorial Day dates, no flowers, planters, pots, memorabilia, toys, shells, crockery jars, metal signs are allowed on the ground at the cemetery.
7. Fruits and vegetables, food and drink are at no time permitted on any lot or monument.
8. Cemetery maintenance crews will remove anything and everything that does not meet the regulations listed above.

Please help us to maintain the beauty and integrity of this sacred ground.
